

Pesticide Spraying Notification

Del Mar Union School District

Dear Parent or Guardian,

The Healthy Schools Act of 2000 requires all California school districts to notify parents or guardians of pesticides they expect to apply during the year. The District office and school sites may be treated with the following pesticides and ECO friendly products.

Drione	Pyrethrin, Silica Aerogel
Maxforce FC	Fipronil
Precor	Methoprene
Precore 2000 Plus	Permethrin, Methoprene
PT Wasp-Freeze	Phenothrin d-Trans Allethrin
Termidor	Fipronil
*ECO Exempt G	Eugenol (Clover Oil), Thyme Oil
*ECO Exempt IC2	Rosemary Oil, Peppermint Oil
*Mother Earth Exempt G	Cedar Oil

**These chemicals are exempt from notification regulations established by AB2260. This information is provided voluntarily by the Del Mar Union School District.*
