I am a parent of a Torrey Hills student, and I would like to contribute my voice to the discussion about the placement of DMUSD offices and the potential for school closures or joint use options for schools within the district.

Please consider two factors: financial stability, and school site integrity.

We can't build new offices in these tough times. There are offices already at Del Mar Hills. Please do not divide Torrey Hills into classrooms and office. It would degrade the quality of education. Put offices in places designated specifically for that purpose

For these reasons I urge the members of the 7/11 committee to vote for proposal B. I know there are some passionate voices urging you to “save” all schools, but on paper, this does not make financial sense for the district, nor does it reflect long-term growth projections for the district. Please, use our district monies and resources smartly, and keep schools and office sites separate.
