As parents of young children at Del Mar Heights School, we are imploring you not to close Del Mar Hills school and combine the two schools. Del Mar, west of the 5, is a young community and there are so many young children in our neighborhood who will need both schools to be open in order to have the opportunity to attend a school in their neighborhood. The actual schools are infinitely smaller than the larger, newer schools East of the 5 and they do not have the capacity to merge into one school.

There are other options!!!! The district offices can be split and moved to the larger schools East of the 5.
