Children's Creative Workshops (CCW) is once again planning for an enriching summer program. Started in 1981 and administered by the Del Mar Union School District, the purpose of CCW is to provide interactive, engaging and creative opportunities for all elementary children.

Each year we seek skilled, imaginative, enthusiastic individuals who provide diverse learning experiences, who will enjoy sharing their expertise and special interests with children. Our staff consists of credentialed teachers as well as community members with unique talents.

CCW operates two 2-week sessions each summer and will be located at one of the Del Mar Union School District schools, with its exact site still to be determined. Classes will meet for two 90-minute sessions daily from 9:00 a.m. – 10:30 a.m. and 10:30 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. Instructors may offer up to two classes each session; however, we cannot guarantee that all requests will be honored. Our pre-kindergarten and pre-first grade programs consist of a series of three, forty-five minute classes. This summer's dates are **Session I (July 5 – July 15)** and **Session II (July 18 – July 29)**. The instructor's salary is \$27.00 per hour. Supplies will be provided.
