Children's Creative Workshops (CCW) is once again offering a summer program of enrichment and enjoyment for elementary school students. CCW began offering summer workshops in 1981 and is administered by the Del Mar Union School District. The purpose of the workshops is to provide a creative and enriching experience that does not duplicate the school-year curriculum.

We are seeking skilled, creative, enthusiastic individuals who will provide diverse learning experiences, primarily in the area of fine arts and who will enjoy sharing their expertise and special interests with children. Our staff consists of credentialed teachers as well as community members with unique talents.

This year, CCW will be at Ashley Falls Elementary School in the Del Mar Union School District. The dates for **Session I are July 12 – July 23** and **Session II are July 26 – August 6**. Classes will meet for two 90-minute sessions daily from 9:00 a.m. – 10:30 a.m. and 10:30 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. Instructors may offer up to two classes each session; however, we cannot guarantee that all requests will be honored. Our pre-kindergarten and pre-first grade programs consist of a series of three, forty-five minute classes.

If you have unique experiences, special abilities, or an interesting topic/subject matter that you would like to share/explore with children, please complete an application form for each class proposal. **In order to be considered for a position, we must receive your application by February 28, 2010.** CCW will notify all applicants of employment by May 15th. The instructor's salary is \$27.00 per hour. Supplies will be provided.
