Ms. Stevenson, DMSEF President, presented a check in the amount of \$101,000 bringing the total donations from the DMSEF to \$1,181,000, which equates to 13.1 FTEs. Historical trends will not apply to the 2010-2011 fiscal year and assumptions will change as information becomes available from the Governor. Ms. Whittington fielded clarifying questions from the Board.

10.15 Approval of Temporary Loans from County Treasury within 2010/2011 Fiscal Year Resolution No 2010-11

Dena Whittington, Assistant Superintendent, Business Services, reported that for the past five years the Del Mar Union School District has participated in the pooled financing program through the issuance of Tax and Revenue Anticipation Note (TRAN), however, due to an increase in cash flow from ARRA (American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009) and delay in the "Fair Share" reduction, it was determined by the underwriter that the district did not qualify to participate this year. Ms. Whittington asked for approval on another option available to the District, should a shortfall occur, which is to request a temporary loan from the County Treasury up to 85% of estimated taxes to be accrued for fiscal year 2010-2011. Ms. Whittington fielded clarifying questions from the Board.

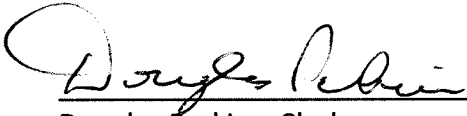
