

Sycamore Ridge School Celebrates International Day of Peace 2010!

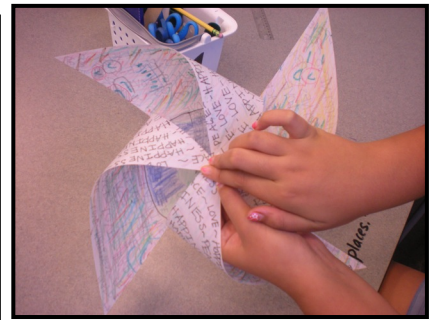
Sycamore Ridge Students are PeaceBuilders
