

Frequently Asked Questions

Q. How does my child get to their Enrichment class?

- A. Escorts are not available to walk children to their Enrichment class. For the safety of the children, if a child is unfamiliar with the campus, parents must accompany their child or make arrangements to have someone direct their child to the proper location for the class (please do not ask classroom teacher to do this). If you feel at some point your child may walk on his/her own, then you as a parent can make that decision.

Q. My child is not in the grade range of a class being offered. Can he/she still sign up for the class?

- A. Per parent feedback and requests received from Enrichment surveys, classes are offered to a range of three grade levels. Only students in the specific grade range that a class is offered to will be permitted to register.

Q. What is the best way to turn in the registration form? In what order are the registrations processed?

- A. Enrichment classes are limited to 15 students per instructor. The best way to return the registration is to drop it off at the school office or put it in the mail. Wherever the registration form is received, it is dated. Example: If 20 registrations are received on the same day, for the same class, the first 15 opened will be admitted to the class. We process approximately 1600 registrations and this method has proven to be the most efficient.

Q. Will I receive confirmation that my child is in a class?

- A. No. Classes are confirmed unless otherwise notified. You will receive an email or letter in the mail if a class your child has signed up for is full or canceled. Confirmed classes/schedules will also be posted on the After School Programs/After School Enrichment website two weeks prior to the start of classes.

Q. My child is not sure if he/she wants to take a specific class. Can I sign him/her up and cancel later if he/she changes his/her mind?

- A. Class sizes are limited to 15 students per instructor. Some classes fill quickly and we encourage you only to sign up if your child is truly interested. Once classes fill, we often have to turn children away who are very interested in the class. **Once classes are established, no refunds will be made. Classes are considered to be established two weeks before the class start date.**

Q. Why are classes cancelled?

- A. Classes have a minimum amount of students required (7) per the instructors. If this is not met, classes are cancelled. The After School Programs Office makes every effort not to cancel classes too soon because parents often sign up past the registration due date and their registration may be the deciding factor in whether a class can go.

Q. Should my child choose a second choice class?

- A. We highly recommend selecting a second choice class in the event your child's first choice is full or cancelled. If your child's first choice class is full or cancelled, but a second choice class has been specified, your child will be enrolled in that class, permitting space is available and based on when your registration was received. You will be notified via email if your child has been placed in a second choice class.
