MONDAY, Feb. 20 • Animals Have a Sweet Tooth too!

Campers will meet: a miniature horse, a dog, a bearded dragon, a guinea pig and a snake.

TUESDAY, February 21 • Winter in the Wild

Discover the secrets to how animals survive the winter all over the globe!

Campers will meet: a sheep, the walking sticks, a snake, a dove and a turtle.

WEDNESDAY, February 22 • Eye Spy!

Come play "eye spy" with our various animals, and learn how they use their different types of eyes to survive in the wild!

Campers will meet: a goat, cats and dogs from our Adoptions department, a leopard gecko and the sulcatas.

THURSDAY, February 23 • Tropical Treasures

Our rainforests are a treasure chest full of amazing animals and plants. Explore the rainforest in winter with us and discover why jungles are the richest of all habitats.

Campers will meet: a parrot, a cockroach, a crested gecko, a frog and a cat.

FRIDAY, February 24 • Who is Wearing What?

Fur and feathers and scales, Oh My! Let our animal ambassadors teach you about the different types of animal coverings, and determine who wears what covering!

Campers will meet: a fish, a cockatiel, a hermit crab, a rabbit, and a blue-tongued skink.

When is Feb. Critter Camp?

- Feb. 20-24, for grades Pre-K to 5

CAMP HOURS:

- Pre-K (children must be at least 4): 9a.m. to 1p.m.
- Grades K-5: 9a.m. to 3p.m.

OPTIONAL EXTENDED CARE (excluding late pickup for Pre-K): \$15.00/day. First drop off 8:00am / Latest pickup 5:00pm

What is the cost?

- Pre-K (children must be at least 4): \$40/day or \$180/week*

- Grades K-5: \$55/day or \$245/week*

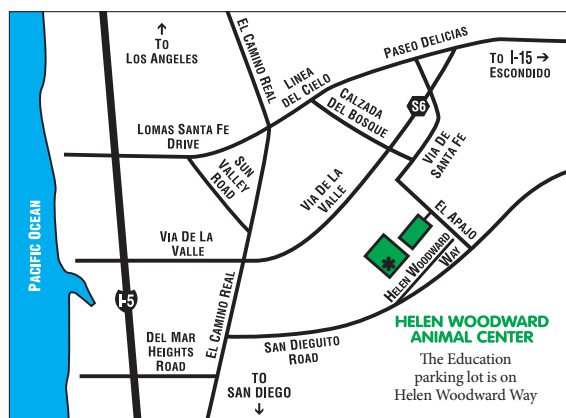
*Scholarships available.

How is the camp organized?

- Class size is limited to 15 children.
- Each group is led by a specially trained educator and two assistants, providing a 5 to 1 ratio.
- We place children in groups based on their grade level.
- All children will need to bring a sack lunch* as well as a light snack and a bottle of water to camp each day.

*Lunch may be purchased through our Critter Camp lunch program.



Please note: Activities are age specific. Animal interaction is dependant upon animal health on a day-to-day basis.
