eBOOKS ARE HERE! Sage Canyon School now has eBooks allowing students to read books online from any workstation with internet access and a web-browser! Your student will have brought home their personal eBooks library card showing the website address, user id, and password by Friday, February 17th. This white library card is attached to a "Quick Reference Guide" flyer. Most of the students have seen a demonstration at school and are very excited about this new way to read books online. eBooks are available to all Sage Canyon students and staff. To access the Sage Canyon School virtual library go to:

Although Follettshelf has a very intuitive user interface, when you first logon with your child, you may visit the online "HELP" function. On the upper right hand corner of the main screen between "Advanced Search" and "Logout" there is a yellow icon with a ?. When the ? icon is selected, you will be directed to a new browser tab containing the Follettshelf "ONLINE HELP" page. When a student checks out a book online, it is placed on their virtual bookshelf for seven days. They are allowed to place two books on their shelf at any time. Additionally, there are many books that have unlimited access meaning these books are always available for students to read at any time.
