Awards for Qualifiers

Plaques will be given to each competitor that makes main at their first ASA Qualifier Saturday Event. To earn ASA points Riders must compete in both Saturday and Sunday Events. Place plates are given to a rider for each Qualifier.

All SCR Events will have an award of the day

Qualifications For Series Award: A rider must race 4 races during the 2016 ASA Florida Cup Series plus the Series Championship.

All riders who make the main in the *All-Star Championship race and were qualified will receive a HRP Number Plate at the award ceremony.

Riders 1st-4th for overall series points will be awarded a trophy.

End of Series awards will be based on USABMX Age and Skill groups.

Florida All-Star Qualification Competition Structure:

1. It takes 4 *All-Star qualifiers to qualify plus the Championship race.
2. In the event a rider has more than 4 *All-Star qualifiers, only the best scores will count.
3. *All-Star AND SCR events will be run utilizing the **TOTAL POINTS FORMAT**. Each rider races 3 qualifying motos and the highest scoring rider does NOT transfer to the main event. The main event finish is the racers overall finish of the day. Total Point motos shall be scored in the following manner:
 - a. Finish positions shall be tallied for each of three motos:
 - + One point for 1st
 - + Two points for 2nd
 - + Three points for 3rd, and so on.
 - + A rider that misses a moto or receives a flagrant disqualification from moto will receive one point more than the total number of riders in that moto
 - b. If a tie exists after the three motos, the best finish on the third moto between tied participants will determine the transfer
4. **Gold Cup event at Orlando is not an All-Star event and will be run utilizing the USABMX Transfer system.
- 4.5. Each rider's final *All-Star points total will be within the age/skill group that corresponds with his/her actual age/skill as of the series Championship date.
- 5.6. In the event of a tie in *All-Star final points
 - a. Higher proficiency (applies to 20" Class only).
 - b. Best finish at the *All-Star Championship event
 - c. Total number of riders in class
 - d. Order of transfer from the motos. (If a total points race, the finish order shall be used as the transfer order for that rider.)
 - e. Most number of single point races competed in
 - f. If there is still a tie at this point, it will be declared a tie, and co-champions will be awarded.
