- All riders racing in their respective age class will earn USA BMX double district points.
- \$10 of all entry fees will be donated to the Bob Warnicke Scholarship!
- -All riders will receive Official Race Certificate.
- Strider Specific Track/ Push Bike Track: riders must have membership, bike, and helmet. All can be purchased/rented in registration.

The Bob Warnicke Memorial Scholarship Fund was created to assist students and their families in meeting the costs of undergraduate college education, trade school, etc. USA BMX/BMX Canada members who have a current USA BMX/BMX Canada license or Track Operators/Officials who participate in BMX racing events sanctioned by USA BMX/BMX Canada are eligible to apply.

In 2014, the Warnicke Scholarship program awarded \$45,000 to 31 individual students with BMX backgrounds - selected from 50 applicants. As more tracks and riders get involved in the Warnicke Scholarship races, the number and amount of scholarships awarded will only grow.
