Update on Dec 2021 Flood Relief Efforts







The Salvation Army Malaysia immediately swung into action and focused on two areas that were impacted the greatest: Taman Sri Muda in Shah Alam, Selangor and Mentakab, Pahang with the following after-flood relief efforts:

- 12 homes cleaned
- 125 sets of cleaning kits for people to clean their home
- 53 households who received donations in-kind (clothing, household items, school bags)
- 450 pieces of new single mattresses
- 27 households who received new rice cookers and double-stove burners

We were working alongside with local authorities and local organisations, but we were still facing manpower and volunteer shortages, otherwise we would have been able to widen our scope of our assistance.

2nd Emergency Relief Trip to Saratok







After their first trip in December, the team from The Salvation Army Kuching Corps Community Services made another 6-hour journey to Saratok in January to visit the families who lost their Tembawai Kapok longhouse to a fire.

The team arrived with equipment to enable the households to cook, including gas stoves, LPG tanks and regulators, along with building tools such as wheelbarrows and hammers. Because the residents lived in a rural area and their livelihoods were affected, the team also provided much-needed groceries and freshly baked good thanks to a sponsorship by Taka Bakery.

We want to thank all supporters who made it possible to enable the community to rebuild this home for 150 people.

The Inland Revenue Board (Lembaga Hasil Dalam Negeri or LHDN) has recently issued the revised <u>Guidelines for Application Of Approval Under Subsection 44(6) Of The Income Tax Act 1967</u> (dated 15 May 2019). According to the document, organisations are now required to only issue official tax exemption receipts for donors who provide the following particulars:

- Donor's full name as per NRIC / passport / business registration
- NRIC number / passport number / business registration number
- Complete mailing address of current residence / business location
