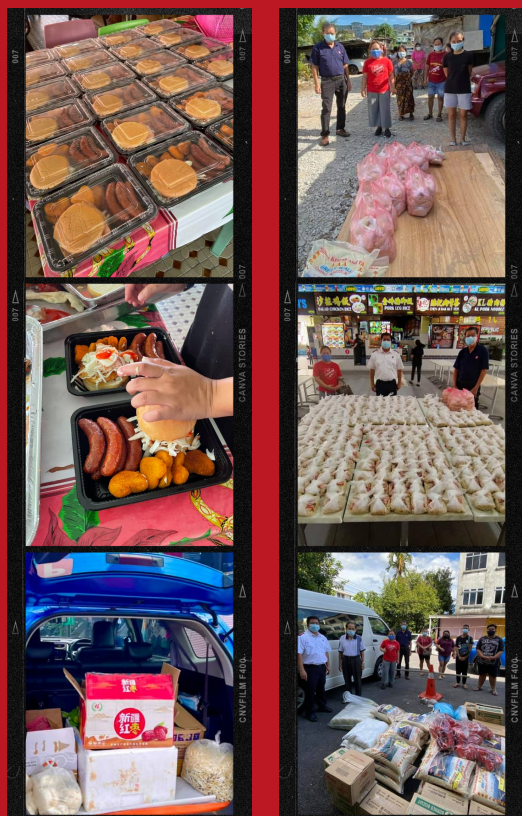

FMCO Food Parcel in Kuching

When the Full Movement Control Order (FMCO) started on 1st June 2021, it also coincided with the Gawai Festival in Sarawak.

To make the Gawai Festival more memorable, fresh hot meals and groceries were distributed at impoverished areas of Kuching (Lorong 13 Chawan and Kampung Kudei Lama) and also to residents of a flat at Taman Suria Jaya Matang who lost their homes to a fire.

Food parcels were also distributed to the same groups in the later weeks that followed, as many residents were not able to work and obtain salaries during the FMCO.

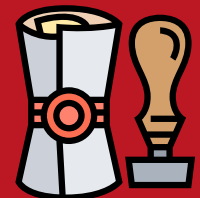
