

Driver's Covenant

Drivers must be 21 years of age, have a valid license, insurance, and liability. Please show your license to event supervisor.

Staff and the Youth Committee reserve the right to ask volunteers not to drive at any time.

Unless extenuating circumstances arise only adults should drive for youth events. If a situation arises, only youth who are related to, arrived with, or have parental permission may ride with another youth.

If you are driving for a youth event you are agreeing to:

- Drive the posted speed limit and nothing faster.
- Obey all traffic laws and drive responsibly. Not only do you have other people's children in your car, but youth also learn from how others drive. Be a good teacher.
- Not smoke while with youth
- Not play offensive music even if the youth suggest it
- Not to text or use applications on cell phones or other electronic devices while driving
- Limit talking on your cell phone unless communicating with other drivers on the trip.
- Refrain from eating and driving. Youth events should be planned to have a time for drivers to stop and eat or to eat before you begin driving.
