Her work has been presented nationally and internationally, including solo exhibits at The Sato Museum of Art, Art-Ing Tokyo/Saison Art Program, Onishi Gallery, and group exhibits at The Flag Art Foundation, Queens Museum of Art, and The Ueno Royal Museum.
