



ALCOHOL POLICY

For the Sale and Service of Alcohol at the Chaska Community Center

It is the policy of the City of Chaska to allow for the consumption of alcohol in the Community Room of the Chaska Community Center. This policy may be terminated at any time by the City of Chaska. Alcohol is permitted to be sold or served in accordance with the 'Rules and Regulations for the Sale or Service of Alcohol' in the Community Room of the Chaska Community Center only (the Sun Room, which is adjacent to the Community Room, is considered part of the Community Room). Alcohol may be sold or served in the Ice Arena area by special permission granted by the Director of Parks and Recreation.

1) **RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE SERVICE OF 3.2 BEER AND WINE** (*Alcohol is free to those attending the event*).

If wine and beer are served at the Community Center by someone other than the holder of a valid existing "on-sale" liquor license, the following rules and regulations must be strictly adhered to:

- a) No Alcohol may be served after 10:00pm on Sunday through Thursday, or after 11:00pm on Friday and Saturday. Alcohol, whether sold or given away may only be served and/or consumed no longer than a continuous 3-hour block of time.
- b) Service and consumption of wine and beer is allowed only in the Community Room and adjacent Sun Room.
- c) Service of alcohol may be served to and consumed only by a person attending the event for which the room or area of the Community Center was rented.
- d) NO alcohol may be served to a minor.
- e) NO alcohol may be served to a person obviously intoxicated.
- f) The person, organization, or group hosting the event must provide the alcohol.
- g) NO compensation of any nature may be exchanged for the alcohol. Examples of prohibited activity under this section include, but are not limited to the following: donations, advanced sale of tickets, tips, payment of any kind to host or organization in exchange for the alcohol, payment for food or music with the alcohol served free, etc.
- h) Other rules and regulations regarding the serving of alcohol at the Chaska Community Center, or the City, may impose. (Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 340A)

- 2) RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE SALE OF 3.2 BEER AND WINE (*Alcohol is being bought by those attending the event*).
- a) No Alcohol may be served after 10:00pm on Sunday through Thursday, or after 11:00pm on Friday and Saturday. Alcohol, whether sold or given away may only be served and/or consumed no longer than a continuous 3-hour block of time.
 - b) Sale of alcohol may only be made by the holder (licensee) of an existing “on-sale” liquor license issued by the City of Chaska, or the cities of Chanhassen, Carver, or Victoria.
 - i) Licensee holding a valid intoxicating liquor license may only sell intoxicating liquor.
 - c) Applicant is responsible for engaging the services of such proposed licensee for the sale of alcohol.
 - d) Proposed licensee must, at least seven (7) days prior to the date of the event at which alcohol is to be sold, deliver to the Chaska Community Center Facility Coordinator a certificate of insurance providing “off-premises” liquor liability coverage, naming the City of Chaska as an additional named insured. Failure to deliver such insurance certificate as stated above, will result in the denial of the sale of alcohol.
 - e) Sale and consumption of wine and beer is allowed only in the Community Room and adjacent Sun Room.
 - f) Sale of alcohol may be sold to and consumed only by a person attending the event for which the room or area of the Community Center was rented.
 - g) NO alcohol may be sold to a minor.
 - h) NO alcohol may be sold to a person obviously intoxicated.
 - i) Sale of alcohol must be in accordance with Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 340A (Minnesota Liquor Laws).
 - j) Other rules and regulations regarding the sale of alcohol at the Chaska Community Center, or the City, may impose.
