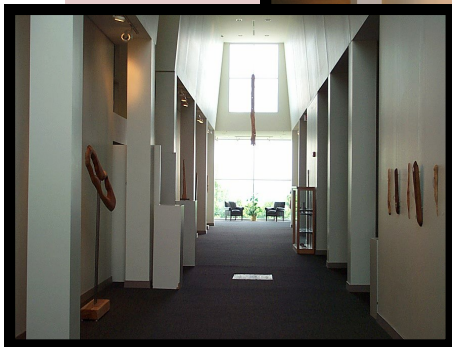


Chaska Community Center Gallery

The rotating exhibits bring warmth to the center and is enjoyed by many.

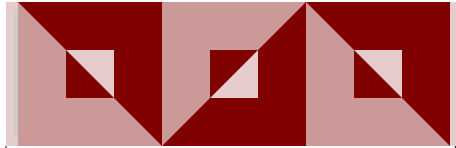

Artists Opportunities

The gallery Chaska Community Center (CCC) Gallery is open to the public and is a family gathering space with many visitors daily.

Eligibility:

All exhibitions are open to emerging and professional artists residing in Minnesota. Priority will go to those residing in Carver County.

Artists may exhibit no more than once every two years. Previous artists who have shown at the CCC must reapply for each exhibition and are not guaranteed a future show. (Exceptions may be granted for city run programs)

Pottery and other free standing art is limited to the display case only. The Gallery cannot accommodate free standing delicate pieces of artwork.

Exhibition Details

Shows generally run 4 to 6 weeks. A show coordinator must be named to be responsible for the set-up, take-down and maintenance of the show.

Artists/coordinators need to stop in periodically and check that the show is still hanging as it should be. All pieces for the show must be framed and labeled with artist's title. All pieces must hang for the entire time of show. If any pieces are removed for repair you must inform the Chaska Community Center Staff before pieces are removed.

The City of Chaska does not provide insurance for artist or artwork.

A City of Chaska waiver form must be signed and returned from each individual artist. A listing of all pieces and their value is needed before the show begins.

The Artist is responsible for coordinating any purchasing of art pieces. The city of Chaska does not take any commission on art sales.

Artists are welcome to schedule an open house with us at no charge.

The City will provide ladders, hanging system wires and hooks, and blue tape (the only adhesive allowed on the walls). Do not cut the wire that is already hanging, please adjust it as needed.

Artists Selection Process

To apply please send:

- Completed application form
- 5-10 digital images emailed to svanhofwegen@chaskamn.com
- A short description of show or artist bio in a word document emailed to svanhofwegen@chaskamn.com

Applications will be collected on an ongoing basis. The City of Chaska Arts Coordinator will hold onto applications and review them twice a year (January and July).

January: Book Summer and Fall of the current year.

July: Book Winter and Spring for next calendar year.

The City of Chaska Arts Coordinator will contact selected artists during these two time frames.
