9 Statement regarding the distribution of property remaining on liquidation


Upon the winding-up or dissolution of the Corporation, the funds and property remaining after payment of all costs, charges and expenses properly incurred in the winding-up or dissolution including the remuneration of a liquidator, and after payment to employees of any arrears of salaries or wages, and after payment of any debts of the Corporation, shall be distributed to such "registered charities" and "qualified donees", as defined in the *Income Tax Act* (Canada), as shall be determined by the Board. Any such funds or property which had originally been received for specific purposes shall, wherever possible, be distributed to registered charities or qualified donees carrying on work of a similar nature to such specific purposes.
