## CSPC Prayer Walk Guide

*These stations and prayer topics are simply ideas or suggestions to stimulate your mind and spirit as you pray for our church, congregation, ministries and staff. Use your imagination and let the Holy Spirit guide you as you picture in your mind God's work on our campus.*

*II Chron 7:11-16 John 15:4,5,7 I John 5:14-15*

- 1. Sanctuary** – Our mission is to Love God, Love One Another, and Serve the World proclaiming the love of Christ. We come primarily to love, honor and worship God. Pray for our worship services and music ministries. Pray for John's preaching – God's leading and filling with the Holy Spirit; for God's word to do its work transforming lives. Ask God to make Cedar Springs a House of Prayer.
- 2. East Wing/offices** – Pray for our Pastoral staff, elders, deacons and women's ministry leaders. Seek God's leading and discernment as they make decisions about the church and ministry. Pray for protection from Satan and temptation, purity, unity and filling of the Holy Spirit.
- 3. Education/Nursery building** – Sunday school classes, discipleship programs, childrens ministry, nursery – that we would equip and make disciples to fulfill the Great Commission; that our children's hearts will be open to the need of a personal relationship with Jesus. Pray for staff, teachers and workers and for an abundance of volunteers. Pray for the Healing and Wholeness prayer ministry - that lives will be restored and healed.
- 4. Chapel** – This, our old sanctuary, is a reminder of our 200 year heritage and God's blessing on CSPC. Thank and praise God for his goodness and provision, all the wonderful pastors/teachers he has brought, and our long faithfulness to His Word. Pray for repentance and revival. The chapel hosts many smaller and special services such as weddings and funerals. Pray for folks that are grieving and those celebrating. Pray for strong marriages in our church.
- 5. Family Life Center** – Pray that our sports ministries will build strong families and build character in youth and adults. Pray that sports coaches will exemplify Christ. Pray that these ministries will be an effective outreach and evangelism tool to our community. Women's Ministries: Pray that the women of CSPC would be filled with the HS and characterized by kindness, love, grace and truth as they minister in their families and communities.
- 6. Youth/Watershed building** – Pray that our college, high school and middle school youth will be drawn to God and protected from temptation. Pray for our staff to know how to disciple and draw youth to God, faith and community; that our youth will grow in faith and learn to live it out. Pray for the parents of our youth to be the primary spiritual leaders/teachers of their children. Pray for committed adult volunteer leaders.
- 7. Parking lot/overlook at waterfall** – Think of our coming and going: welcoming visitors, ushers, greeters. Pray that we would remember our outward focus as salt and light in Knoxville and the world. Seek revival for Knoxville. Pray for our missionaries and mission to the world – for boldness, effectiveness and wise use of resources. And for God to raise up workers for our Refugee and Int'l and foreign ministries.
