CONDUCT POLICY

The Coral Ridge Student Ministries is under the authority of the Church, due to this fact it is the responsibility of the leaders, students and chaperones to comply with all Church policies that have been set forth. The Church is committed to having God honoring events in all that is promoted by it. Therefore, in agreement with Church policy, if there is any activity that is seen as inappropriate, Student Ministries can no longer support the student, leader or chaperone that is involved in the activity. If anyone is found with possession of alcohol or illegal drugs, they will be sent home. If there is any sexual misconduct those individuals will also be sent home. The leadership reserves the right to send any person home that has not upheld the God-honoring position of the Church. If anyone is sent home, it is not the responsibility of the Church to pay for their fare. The parent of the respective student will be responsible to pay for the fare of the student being sent home. If it is necessary for a chaperone to accompany the student, then it will also be the financial responsibility of the parent to pay for the chaperone. Student Ministries of the Church, as well as other ministries/ departments of the Church, has a responsibility to be a witness to Christ and to our Church. As a member of trips, activities or any events that are sponsored by Student Ministries, it is each attendee's obligation to uphold the positions supported by our Church.
