WHO?

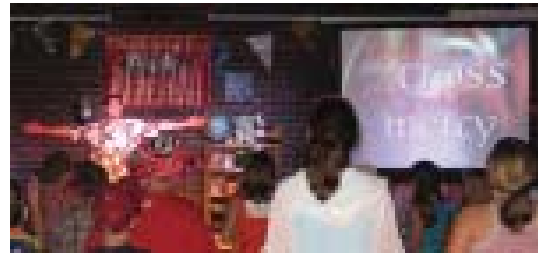
