From I-20 - Take the SC 277 exit (Exit 73) toward Columbia (it becomes Bull Street). After passing Elmwood Avenue, follow Bull Street for seven blocks. The church campus is on the right beginning at Washington Street.

**From I-77** - Take Forest Drive exit (Exit 12) toward Columbia. Forest Drive becomes Taylor Street entering Columbia. Turn South (left) at Bull Street and go two blocks. The church campus is on the right beginning at Washington Street.

First Presbyterian Church parking is available at the corner of Bull Street and Washington Street.

There is also parking available next to the First Presbyterian Church offices at 1420 Lady Street and street parking around the church.
