

DIRECTIONS

First Presbyterian Church is located at 1324 Marion Street, Columbia, South Carolina.

From I-26 - Take I-26 from Charleston or Spartanburg. Follow the I-126 Spur into Columbia (it becomes Elmwood Avenue). Turn South (right) on Bull Street. Stay on Bull Street for seven blocks. The church campus is on the right beginning at Washington Street.

From I-20 - Take the SC 277 exit (Exit 73) toward Columbia (it becomes Bull Street). After passing Elmwood Avenue, follow Bull Street for seven blocks. The church campus is on the right beginning at Washington Street.

From I-77 - Take Forest Drive exit (Exit 12) toward Columbia. Forest Drive becomes Taylor Street entering Columbia. Turn South (left) at Bull Street and go two blocks. The church campus is on the right beginning at Washington Street.

First Presbyterian Church parking is available at the corner of Bull Street and Washington Street.

There is also parking available next to the First Presbyterian Church offices at 1420 Lady Street and street parking around the church.



Dr. R.C. Sproul is president of *Ligonier Academy of Biblical and Theological Studies* and the founder and chairman of *Ligonier Ministries*. He is executive editor of *Tabletalk* magazine and general editor of *The Reformation Study Bible*. Dr. Sproul currently serves as the director of *Serve International* and Senior Minister of Preaching and Teaching at Saint Andrew's in Sanford, Florida. He is ordained as a teaching elder in the Presbyterian Church in America.

Dr. Sproul is the author of more than seventy books and scores of articles for national evangelical publications. Dr. Sproul has produced more than 300 lecture series and has recorded more than 80 video series on subjects such as the history of philosophy, theology, Bible study, apologetics, and Christian living. Dr. Sproul's teaching can be heard on the program *Renewing Your Mind with Dr. R. C. Sproul*.

Dr. Sproul holds degrees from Westminster College, Pittsburgh Theological Seminary, and the Free University of Amsterdam, and has had a distinguished academic teaching career at various colleges and seminaries, including Reformed Theological Seminary in Orlando, Florida, and Jackson, Mississippi.
