

Glorified Body – Scripture

I Corinthians 15:40-53

1Co 15:40 There are heavenly bodies and earthly bodies, but the glory of the heavenly is of one kind, and the glory of the earthly is of another.

1Co 15:41 There is one glory of the sun, and another glory of the moon, and another glory of the stars; for star differs from star in glory.

1Co 15:42 So is it with the resurrection of the dead. What is sown is perishable; what is raised is imperishable.

1Co 15:43 It is sown in dishonor; it is raised in glory. It is sown in weakness; it is raised in power.

1Co 15:44 It is sown a natural body; it is raised a spiritual body. If there is a natural body, there is also a spiritual body.

1Co 15:45 Thus it is written, "The first man Adam became a living being"; the last Adam became a life-giving spirit.

1Co 15:46 But it is not the spiritual that is first but the natural, and then the spiritual.

1Co 15:47 The first man was from the earth, a man of dust; the second man is from heaven.

1Co 15:48 As was the man of dust, so also are those who are of the dust, and as is the man of heaven, so also are those who are of heaven.

1Co 15:49 Just as we have borne the image of the man of dust, we shall also bear the image of the man of heaven.

1Co 15:50 I tell you this, brothers: flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God, nor does the perishable inherit the imperishable.

1Co 15:51 Behold! I tell you a mystery. We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed,

1Co 15:52 in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised imperishable, and we shall be changed.

1Co 15:53 For this perishable body must put on the imperishable, and this mortal body must put on immortality.

II Corinthians 1:21-22

2Co 1:21 And it is God who establishes us with you in Christ, and has anointed us,

2Co 1:22 and who has also put his seal on us and given us his Spirit in our hearts as a guarantee.

Ephesians 1:13-14

Eph 1:13 In him you also, when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation, and believed in him, were sealed with the promised Holy Spirit,

Eph 1:14 who is the guarantee of our inheritance until we acquire possession of it, to the praise of his glory.

Philippians 3:20-21

Php 3:20 But our citizenship is in heaven, and from it we await a Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ,

Php 3:21 who will transform our lowly body to be like his glorious body, by the power that enables him even to subject all things to himself.

I John 3:2

1Jn 3:2 Beloved, we are God's children now, and what we will be has not yet appeared; but we know that when he appears we shall be like him, because we shall see him as he is.

John 17:22, 24

Joh 17:22 The glory that you have given me I have given to them, that they may be one even as we are one...

Joh 17:24 Father, I desire that they also, whom you have given me, may be with me where I am, to see my glory that you have given me because you loved me before the foundation of the world.

Genesis 1:26-27

Gen 1:26 Then God said, "Let us make man in our image, after our likeness. And let them have dominion over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the heavens and over the livestock and over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth."

Gen 1:27 So God created man in his own image, in the image of God he created him; male and female he created them.

Genesis 2:7

Gen 2:7 then the LORD God formed the man of dust from the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life, and the man became a living creature.

Genesis 2:19-20a

Gen 2:19 Now out of the ground the LORD God had formed every beast of the field and every bird of the heavens and brought them to the man to see what he would call them. And whatever the man called every living creature, that was its name.

Gen 2:20a The man gave names to all livestock and to the birds of the heavens and to every beast of the field.

The Lord's Resurrection body

- It looked like His earthly person
 - Mary Magdalene recognized Him at the tomb - John 20:16
 - The two men recognized Him at Emmaus - Luke 24:31
- He could control the atomic structure
 - He appeared to the disciples behind locked doors - John 20:19
 - He vanished from the presence of the two men at Emmaus - Luke 24:31
 - He holds all things together - Colossians 1:17
- The crucifixion wounds were visible
 - He appeared to the disciples - John 20:20
 - He appeared to Thomas - John 20:27
- His body contained flesh and bones - Luke 24:39
- He was able to eat - Luke 24:42 - 43
- He was able to speak - Luke 24:38
- He had a physical body
 - He presented Himself alive after His suffering by many proofs - Acts 1:3
 - His body died, was buried, was resurrected and appeared to many people - I Corinthians 15:3 - 8
- He was able to control gravity
 - His body was lifted up in their sight - Acts 1:9
 - He will return in the same manner - Acts 1:11
- He is physically sitting by the Father in Heaven - Mark 16:19
