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Course Description

This course is the second part of an introduction to systematic theology. We will cover the atonement and salvation, the person and work of the Holy Spirit, the purpose of organization of the church, Biblical prophecy regarding the end times, and more.

Course Objectives

Students will . . .

- Survey different areas of systematic theology using Charles Ryrie's *Basic Theology*
- Be able to identify central passages concerning the various topics studied
- Be able to explain the key issues surrounding selected doctrinal debates
- Learn to appreciate the importance of sound doctrine

Course Requirements

Reading (5 points each, 60 points total)

Each week the student will have several chapters to read out of Ryrie. The students are required to complete all the required reading before the class begins so that they will be able to participate in and benefit from the class discussions. At the beginning of each exam there will be a place to check off your reading progress.

Assignments (10 points each, 120 points total)

Each week there will be several questions that correspond to the reading. The students are required to complete all the reading questions before each class. If a student misses class, it is their responsibility to contact the instructor or another student to get a copy of the questions for the following week.

Exams (100 points each, 200 points total)

There will be two take-home exams. A mid-term exam due on October 16th and a final exam due on December 11th.

Attendance

In order to maintain high standards of learning, students will only be allowed two absences per course. Any exceptions must be approved by the course instructor.
