### Rooftop Friends Areas of Focus:

- Provide monthly activities for disabled individuals that also provide a much-needed respite for the disabled individual's caregiver(s).
- Host a family retreat every summer. This retreat is held at Camp ASCCA (Alabama's Special Camp for Children and Adults) and gives families of disabled individuals a chance to vacation together and gives the disabled individual a chance to try new activities with their volunteer “buddy” and other disabled friends.
  - Work with volunteers to provide a “buddy system” at Young Meadows Presbyterian Church to provide disabled individuals a helper during worship services and activities so that family members and caregivers of disabled individuals can participate in worship and activities themselves. In time, Rooftop Friends hopes to help other churches implement this buddy system.
- Provide get-togethers, counseling and mentoring for the siblings of individuals with disabilities.
  - Help with fundraising for the support of disabled campers and volunteer helpers.
  - Support and collaborate with like-minded Alabama organizations and ministries.
