

OPPORTUNITY PROGRAMS ELIGIBILITY

The Counseling Department at Clinton maintains as a priority the expansion of after school, summer and college opportunities for all students. To help us achieve this shared goal, we ask that you check one or both of the following if they apply to your and/or your family. If you check one of these boxes, please return this form by taking a photo of this form and emailing it to Upper Grades Counselor, Tim David-Lang at tdavid-lang@theclintonschool.net or by mail to the attention of the Counseling Department.

[] Our child **WILL** be the first generation to attend college (*meaning: parents do not have a **Bachelor's Degree***). **OR**

[] Our family **IS** eligible for Free or Reduced Lunch as defined by at least one of the guidelines listed below.

- You're enrolled in or eligible to participate in the National School Lunch Program (NSLP).
- Your annual family income falls within the Income Eligibility Guidelines set by the USDA Food and Nutrition Service (see box below)
- You're enrolled in a federal, state, or local program that aids students from low-income families (e.g., Federal TRIO programs such as Upward Bound).
- Your family receives public assistance.
- You live in federally subsidized public housing or a foster home, or are homeless.
- You are a ward of the state or an orphan.

1. The household size should be the number of household members **plus** the filer in the family's current income tax statement. A student who is in foster care is considered a household size of one person.

2. Income levels are based on the USDA Food and Nutrition Service Income Eligibility Guidelines used by schools, institutions and facilities participating in the National School Lunch Program.

More than 6 members in the household?

To determined income levels for families with more than 6 household members, take the annual allowance for six members and add \$7,696 for each additional member.
