

Easy Way to Mat Photo for Scottsdale Arabian Horse Show Photo

1. Select your photo. Print it.

These are links to on line printing. You can go to CVS, Walgreens, or Walmart and print them. Take a few minutes and explore the links.

- **Hint:** Inkjet printer pictures vary in quality. If you decide to go that route use photo paper to print them on for best presentation.

2. Mat your picture. Goggle “mat photos” and you get a ton of information. Below is the description of an easy way to do it.



- Mats can be purchased in Michael's, Joann's and Hobby Lobby near in their framing department. Before you shop download the stores app and get a coupon. Joann's offers packages of 4. It is the best deal if you are entering more than one photo.

- **HINT:** WHITE mats, please. The color is tempting.
- **HINT:** Pictures that are 5x7 or bigger display better in the contest. Smaller and they just get lost. Winners in the past were larger.

3. Assemble your tools – mat, picture, tape and entry form.



4. Center and tape your picture and attach your entry form. Tape the edges of the photo completely.
- **HINT:** Captions matter. The judge likes the creativeness of them in relationship to the photo.
