

New Halter Paddock Rules

The Arabian Horse Association of Arizona has implemented new rules for the paddock and entry area for all Halter classes. These rules will be strictly followed.

EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY, one person per class will be designated to assist with the entry of the Halter classes. Only that person will be allowed to use any sort of device to enhance the performance of the Halter horses. The designated person will be provided a whip with appendages that can be used to enhance the Halter horses in the paddock area. No other devices will be allowed. No one, including the designated person, will be allowed to hit or use any other objects, such as trash cans, walls, plastic signs, etc. to make additional noise. Additionally, no one will be permitted to use plastic or paper bags of any type or size in assisting with entrance into the Halter arena.

Should this rule/policy be violated, the person violating the rule and the handler and/or trainer associated with the person violating the rule can be subject to sanctions.
