ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible, the rider must compete in at least one Grand Prix at four HITS Desert Circuit shows prior to the week of the AIG Million. The top 40 qualified riders will be notified and will be given a deadline by which to declare their intent to show. No rider's spot in the AIG Million will be guaranteed until he/she has officially entered (see Entry Procedure below). If any rider declines, the next rider in the standings will be notified until all 40 slots are filled. In the event that two or more riders are tied for the final qualifying position, all those tied will qualify. The top 20 qualified riders who enter will be eligible to ride two (2) horses. All other riders may ride one (1) horse.

ENTRY PROCEDURE

All Qualified Riders must be officially entered by 5 pm, Monday, March 12. Entry Form available in Show Office. Payment must accompany entry. An entry without payment may be declined and the next rider in line will be invited. **After 5 pm, Monday, March 12, entry fee is not refundable under any circumstance.**

SECURE STABLING

Horses must purchase a stall on the grounds of HITS Desert Horse Park. Horses must be stabled on the grounds **beginning Wednesday, noon, March 14** and must declare their stall location to the Show Office. Horses must remain on the grounds until the conclusion of the AIG Million. The **Wednesday, noon, March 14** stipulation will be strictly enforced.

RIDERS MEETING

A MANDATORY Riders Meeting will be held **Friday, March 16 at the end of the Show Day**. Attendance by the Rider is required. Any conflicts must be approved via agreement with the Show Committee. An Agent or Representative in attendance does not satisfy this requirement.

SUBSTITUTIONS

Since it is the rider who is qualified, substitution of horse may be made at any time, but should be made the day before the class if possible. The Substitute Horse must have been stabled on the grounds according to the procedure above, and must follow any other stipulations regarding schooling, lunging, etc. Substitution must be made in the Show Office by completing the Official Class Entry Blank for the new horse.

Any questions or discrepancies not covered herein with regard to qualifying, eligibility or class conditions or specifications with regard to the AIG Million will be decided by Show Management, its decision to be final.

ORDER OF GO – The order will be reverse order of the Final Standings. The five discretionary spots and any additional discretionary spots will be placed first, their order to be drawn. The rider qualifying from the Arizona Winter Circuit will be placed according to their money won.

Definite Entries due by Wednesday, January 24, 2018

FEI NOMINATING FEE PER HORSE - \$750

OFFICIAL ENTRY - Horses must be Officially Entered for the FEI Division and pay the non-refundable FEI Deposit Fee of \$500 by Wednesday, January 24, 5 pm. Official Entry consists of registration through the FEI system and entry made directly to HITS. FEI Deposit Fee is not refundable after the Definite Date of Entries.

SCRATCH / WITHDRAWAL - Any Scratch/Withdrawal from the FEI Division must be made in writing to the Show Office. Scratches received prior to January 24, 5 pm (Definite Entry Date) will be subject to a \$75 Processing fee if the horse does not show in any other classes. Scratches received after the Definite Entry Date will be responsible for payment of the \$500 FEI Deposit Fee. The Scratch/Refund policy will be applied to any horse entered through the FEI system and/or entered directly with the show. NOTE: In the case of a scratch, also be sure to contact your NF to officially withdraw through the FEI system.

SUBSTITUTIONS:

Substitutions will be accepted until one hour prior to the jog. The horse being substituted for will be subject to a \$75 Processing fee if it does not show in any other classes.

FEI SPECIFICATIONS

For all details not covered below, refer to Official FEI Draft Schedule or the FEI Horse and Rider Information page of this Prize List. Updates will also be posted at HitsShows.com.

ELIGIBILITY - FEI DIVISION - Open to Riders eligible based on FEI Rules for CSI-W events. Refer to Draft Schedule.

ELIGIBILITY - WORLD CUP CLASS 725: A maximum of 40 riders will be eligible for the World Cup Qualifier based on results of class 722. Riders showing two horses in Class 722 must declare their "World Cup Qualifying" horse, and must ride this horse first in the order of go. The rider may qualify for the World Cup riding any horse, however, the horse to be shown in the World Cup must complete the initial round in another FEI class at the show prior to competing in the World Cup. Additionally, the horse may not compete in any other class on the same day as the World Cup Qualifier.

HORSES PER RIDER LIMIT - Riders may enter a total of Three horses for the FEI Division. Riders are limited to Two horses in classes 722 and 723, and One horse in class 725. Refer to Draft Schedule for Details.

CLASS ENTRY/DECLARATION - Declarations must be made in writing in the Show Office by 4 pm the day before the class. After that time, the Post Entry fee will apply to late Declarations; Scratch Fee will apply to any scratch. Once the class has started it may not be scratched. In the case of a Vet Scratch, Scratch Fee will still apply.

CROSS ENTRY RESTRICTIONS - Horses may NOT cross enter into any non-FEI class at the same show. Riders may NOT cross enter into any Junior or Amateur Jumper Class at the same show.

FEI STALLS - FEI Horse Stall fee for FEI Showing Horses is included in the FEI Entry Fee. FEI Stalls for Tack, Feed, Grooming, etc., or for Non-Showing/Scratched Horses is \$500. Stalls in the FEI Stabling area measure 144 square feet and are of both Permanent and Temporary construction, with doors. Horses must be entered in the FEI Division to be eligible for Secure Stabling. Secure Stabling is available beginning Monday, February 5, 12 noon, and ends Monday, February 12, 12 noon.

OFFICIAL JOG - Wednesday, February 7, 7am. This jog is for horses entered in the FEI Division. Please check with the Stabling Office for stabling assignment prior to the jog.

SECURE STABLING - Horses entered in any class of the FEI Division are required to stable in the FEI Secure Stabling area beginning Wednesday immediately following the jog until the horse is finished showing in the FEI Division.

CREDENTIALS - Special credentials will be required for all owners, riders, trainers, grooms wishing to access the FEI Barn. Credentials will be distributed at the Jog

IDENTIFICATION - Once the horse has entered Secure Stabling it must wear its assigned entry number when not in its stall. Horses may be ridden or exercised only in the supervised designated Schooling Areas.

RIDING/SCHOOLING/LUNGEING SCHEDULE - To be posted.

ELIGIBILITY - Open to all. Riders are limited to four (4) horses in this class. Horses are not required to show in any other class at the competition, but may compete in any class for which they are otherwise eligible. Owners, Riders and Trainers must be current Active Competing Members of USEF and USHJA. Horses must have USEF Recording and USHJA Registration. Change of rider after the First Round is not permissible.

CONDITIONS & SPECIFICATIONS - Fences 3'6"-4', with at least four (4) option fences 4'3" or higher per round. To be judged under the Open Numerical scoring system by two panels of two judges each. One Panel will be designated the tie-breaking panel for Round 1; this panel will also be the tie-breaking panel for the jump-off, if any. The other Panel will be the tie-breaking panel for Round 2. To be scored on quality, movement, jumping style, manners and way of going. Pace and brilliance are to be rewarded. Jumping decorations to utilize a shorter track is not permissible in any round.

Round 1: To be shown over a Hunter Classic course of at least 10 fences. In addition to the base score, each judging panel must award an Option Bonus Score consisting of one additional point for every higher height option fence jumped. Scores will be added to determine the total score for the round. The top 12 will return in reverse of scores for the Second Round. In the case of ties, the Base score of the tie-breaking panel will be used to break the tie.

Round 2: To be shown over a Handy Hunter course of at least 10 fences. In addition to the base score, each judging panel must award an Option Bonus Score consisting of one additional point for every higher height option fence jumped and a Handy Bonus Score between zero and 10 bonus points. Scores will be added to determine the total score for the round. In the case of ties, the Base score of the tie-breaking panel will be used to break the tie.

Scores from Round 1 and Round 2 will be added to determine the overall winners. In the case of a tie for First Place, a Jump-off will be held. In the case of ties for all other places, the Base score of the Round 2 tie-breaking panel will be used to break the tie.

Round 3: In the case of an overall tie for First Place, a Jump-off will be held. To be shown over a course of at least 8 fences. Scoring to be the same as for the Handy Hunter Round. Jump-off score to be added to the total score from Round 1 and Round 2 to determine the winners.

POINTS & AWARDS - In order to earn USEF Horse of the Year points, exhibitors must declare in which section points are to count by submitting a completed USHJA Declaration Form to the Show Office by the end of the competition. Only Juniors and Amateurs may declare for the applicable Junior or Amateur-Owner section. In order to earn points toward IHD Awards and Finals, Horses must be enrolled in the International Hunter Derby program. Enrollment is not required to compete in the class.

SECURE STABLING - Horses must purchase a stall and be stabled on the grounds 24 hours prior to the start of the class. Horses must remain on the competition grounds until finished competing in the Derby. Any horse in violation of this requirement will be disqualified.

HORSE INSPECTION - Horses must jog for soundness during the Official Jog the morning of the class. Time and location to be announced. Horses must be officially entered in the Derby prior to the jog. If a horse does not pass the jog, there will be one opportunity for the horse to be re-presented at a time to be determined, up to one hour prior to the start of the class.

SCHOOLING REQUIREMENTS - During the 24 hour period prior to the class, horses must be ridden in official horse show schooling areas only. Competition number must be worn at all times while mounted.

ORDER OF GO - The Order of Go for the First Round will be drawn. The Order for the Second Round will be reverse order of scores from Round 1. The Order for the Jump-off, if any, will be the same as that for Round 2.

ATTIRE - Formal attire required. Buff breeches and shadbelly, white breeches and dark or scarlet coat, hunt colors coat or official sponsor or team jacket permitted.

RIBBONS & AWARDS - Ribbons 1-12 for First Round, Second Round and Overall.
