ENTRY POLICY

Definite Entries due Wednesday, August 22, 2018, 5 pm

FEI DIVISION FEE: \$2,230

ELIGIBILITY - Open to Riders eligible based on FEI Rules for CSI5* events. Refer to Draft Schedule.

OFFICIAL ENTRY - Horses must be Officially Entered for the FEI Division and pay a non-refundable Entry Deposit of \$500 by Wednesday, August 22, 5 pm (Definite Entry Date). Official Entry consists of registration through the FEI system and/or entry made directly to HITS. FEI Deposit Fee is not refundable after the Definite Date of Entries.

SCRATCH/WITHDRAWAL - Any Scratch/Withdrawal from the FEI Division must be in writing to the Show Office. Scratches received prior to Wednesday, August 22, 5 pm (Definite Entry Date) will be subject to a \$50 Processing Fee if the horse does not show in any other classes. Scratches received after the Definite Entry Date will be responsible for payment of the FEI Deposit Fee. Once the horse has participated in the Horse Inspection, the full FEI Entry Fee is due. The Scratch/Refund Policy will be applied to any horse entered through the FEI system and/or entered directly with the show. Note: In the case of a scratch, also be sure to contact your NF to officially withdraw through the FEI Entry System.

SUBSTITUTIONS - Substitutions will be accepted until one hour prior to the jog for a fee of \$10. The horse being substituted for will be subject to a \$50 Processing fee if it does not show in any other classes.

FEI SPECIFICATIONS

For all details not covered below, refer to Official FEI Draft Schedule or the FEI Horse and Rider Information page of the Prize List. Updates will also be posted at HITSShows.com.

HORSES PER RIDER LIMIT - Riders may enter a total of Three horses for the FEI Division. Riders are limited to Three horses in class 721, 722 and 723. The horse limit for class 725 will be dependent on the number of riders who enter. See Qualification for Grand Prix below.

***QUALIFICATION FOR GRAND PRIX** - Class 725, Grand Prix, is limited to 50 Entries. If 50 riders enter, riders will be limited to one horse. If fewer than 50 riders enter, riders will be allowed to ride Two horses, however the maximum number of Entries in the class may not exceed 50. Management will determine if Qualification for the Grand Prix will be necessary based on the number of riders entered for the FEI Division at the start of the Horse Inspection. If so, Qualification will be based on the results of class 722. Details will be available at the Horse Inspection. In addition, the Horse competing in the Grand Prix must complete the course in one other FEI class at the show.

CLASS ENTRY/DECLARATION - Declarations must be made in writing in the Show Office by 5 pm the day before the class. Late Declarations subject to approval of Show Management and may require the horse to work first in the Order of Go.

CROSS ENTRY RESTRICTIONS - Horses: May NOT compete in any Non-FEI class from the time of the Horse Inspection until finished competing in the FEI Division. **Riders:** May NOT cross enter into any Junior, Amateur or Amateur-Owner Jumper class at the same show.

SECURE STABLING - Horses entered in any class of the FEI Division are required to stable in the FEI Secure Stabling area beginning Tuesday immediately following the jog until the horse is finished showing in the FEI Division.

FEI STALLS - FEI Horse Stall fee for FEI Showing Horses is included in the FEI Entry Fee. FEI Stalls for Tack, Feed, Grooming, or for non-showing, scratched, or National horses is \$375. Stalls are of permanent construction, measuring 144 square feet with doors. Horses must be entered in the FEI Division to be eligible for Secure Stabling. Secure Stabling Begins: Monday, September 3, 12 noon. Secure Stabling Ends: Monday, September 10, 12 noon.

OFFICIAL JOG - Tuesday, September 4, at 11 am. This jog is for horses entered in the FEI Division. Please check with the Stabling Office for stabling assignment prior to the jog. Horse must move into Secure Stabling immediately following the jog.

CREDENTIALS - Special credentials will be required for all owners, riders, trainers and grooms wishing to access the FEI Barn. Credentials will be distributed at the Jog.

IDENTIFICATION - Once the horse has entered Secure Stabling it must wear its assigned entry number when not in its stall. Horses may be ridden or exercised only in the supervised designated Schooling Areas.

RIDERS MEETING - FEI Riders are required to attend the HITS Championship Riders Meeting at the end of the Show Day Wednesday, September 5.
