Reading the Schedule

Example: **Sci 7B-S1**

Sci 7	=	Course Name
B	=	Spring Semester (A = Fall Semester)
S1	=	Section 1; meets in a two-hour block from 7:45-9:40 a.m. once a week (Tue)
Eng 7B-S1		Meets in a one-hour block from 7:45-8:40 twice a week (Tue / Thu)

- Courses in *italics* are one-semester courses.
- World History 9 is spring only and Civics 9 is fall only.
- PE, Health & Wellness, and Speech meet both fall and spring semesters.

*Start time – Chemistry begins at 2:30 p.m. at TCA North Campus.

Note: Spanish classes are open to students in grades 9-11 only. 7th grade students currently enrolled in College Pathways Spanish 1 will be allowed to continue in Spanish.

Monday is intentionally left free of classes to accommodate established holidays, staff meetings, staff professional development, all-school assemblies, character development programs, etc.
