Reading the Schedule

Example: **Sci 7A-S1**

Sci 7 = Course Name
A = Fall Semester (B = Spring Semester)
S1 = Section 1; meets in a two-hour block from 7:45-9:40 a.m. once a week (Tue)
Eng 7A-S1 Meets in a one-hour block from 7:45-8:40 twice a week (Tue / Thu)

- Courses in *italics* are one-semester courses.
- Civics 9 is fall only; World History 9 is spring only. Students who take Civics will automatically be enrolled in World History 9 at the same period for the spring semester.
- Health & Wellness is a one credit course meeting one time per week for the entire year. (High School only)
- Reading at the College Level is a zero credit course available to college-ready high school students only.

*Start time – Chemistry begins at 2:30 p.m. at TCA North Campus. Students taking a class at College Pathways prior to Chemistry will be bused to the TCA North Campus.

Note: Spanish classes are open to students in grades 9-11 only.

Monday is intentionally left free of classes to accommodate established holidays, staff meetings, staff professional development, and other activities that may require dedicated time without classes.

Friday morning from 7:45-9:40 is periodic all-school assemblies.
