Reading the Schedule

Example: Sci 7A-S1

Sci 7	=	Course Name
A	=	Fall Semester (B = Spring Semester)
S1	=	Section 1; meets in a two-hour block from 7:45-9:40 a.m. once a week (Tue)
Eng 7A-S1		Meets in a one-hour block from 7:45-8:40 twice a week (Tue / Thu)

- Courses in *italics* are one-semester courses. See Course Descriptions for specific semester offerings.
- Civics 9 is fall only. Students who take Civics will automatically be enrolled in World History 9 at the same period for the spring semester.
- Reading at the College Level is a pass/fail, one credit course.

** **Chemistry** begins at 2:30 p.m. at TCA North Campus. Students taking a class at College Pathways prior to Chemistry will be bused to the TCA North Campus. Parents are responsible for student pickup at 4:30pm from TCA North Campus.

Note: Spanish classes are open to students in grades 9-11 only.
