



Details of the Exchange process:

1. One credit equals one acre.
2. The minimum purchase must be one-tenth of an acre.
3. Acres of wetland are defined by USDA NRCS.
4. Credits may be used to offset future wetland conversions; OR to offset past wetland conversions and remain compliant with Food Security Act "Swampbuster regulations.
5. Credit sales are non-refundable or exchangeable after the original sale is completed.
6. The landowner host assumes all future responsibility to maintain the function and value of the wetland.
7. Once the sale is agreed upon, the proper documentation will be completed by NRCS to ensure your compliance.
8. The credit purchase price is determined between the seller host and potential buyer.
9. South Dakota Farm Bureau will facilitate the transaction and manage the long-term maintenance funds.
