Back by Popular Demand... Sunday Express is BACK!

DuFAST reinstated Sunday bus service on July 11, 2010 due to the overwhelming amount of requests made by passengers. This popular bus route provides service to the downtown area, Falls Creek and the retail shopping area which extends from the DuBois Mall to Wal-Mart.

The yearly service schedule for the Sunday bus will be the first Sunday in May through the first Sunday in November. This year's service will run through Sunday, November 6, 2010. Service begins at 9:45 AM and ends at 3:45 PM at St. Michael Terrace.

SOOOO... ABOUT THOSE TRANSFER TICKETS...

Transfers can only be used when the original bus you are boarding can not get you to your final destination on a way trip. You can not use your transfer ticket to board the same bus from where you received the transfer.

Correct use of Transfer Ticket: You board the bus in Falls Creek and need to go to the hospital. A transfer ticket can be used because the Falls Creek bus does not go to the hospital.

Incorrect use of Transfer Ticket: You go to Wal-Mart on the Route 255 bus. You walk to Shop n' Save and want to ride the Mall Plaza bus back to Downtown. This would be considered an incorrect use of the transfer ticket because the Route 255 bus can take you downtown. Remember, transfers can only be used if the original bus you board can not take you to your final destination on a one way trip.

Bus privileges will be suspended for those who try to abuse the system.

DUFAST TRANSIT BUS DEPOT COMING TO ST. MICHAEL TERRACE

Have you heard the good news?! DuFAST Transit has entered into a partnership with the Council of Human Dignity (owners of St. Michael Terrace) to build a bus depot. The depot will provide an enclosed area for passengers to relax comfortably while waiting for the bus. The seating area will be climate controlled so you can wait in the warmth during the winter and the cool air in the summer. Additional features include new benches, landscaping and heated sidewalks.

Work will begin within the next several weeks and is expected to last at least two months.

The work is expected to take place in two
4 different stages so that the buses will con-

tinue to have access to the front of St. Michael Terrace. However, there will be a period of time (approx. 2 weeks) that the buses will not have access to the front of St. Michael Terrace. In this case, buses will be detoured to the back of The Terrace.

DuFAST & the staff at St. Michael Terrace are working to ensure residents and the public are aware of the temporary change. We will keep you posted on the progress and will alert the drivers to any changes that might result from the construction.
