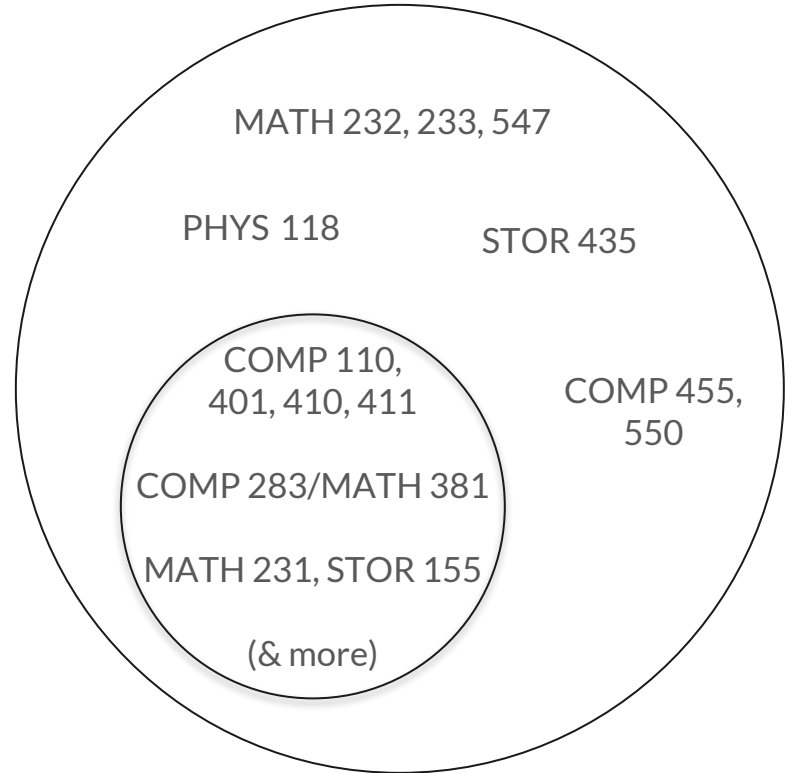


B.S. vs B.A.
