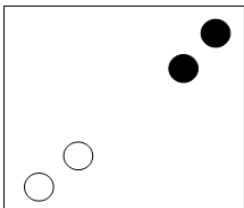
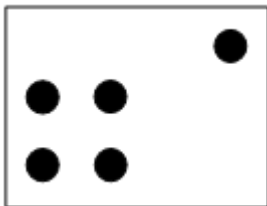

Conceptual Subitizing		Obj: To Rely on Rules of Patterns or Number Concepts when Attending to Additive and Subtractive Concepts $4 \text{ and } 1 = 5$
Additive/Subtractive Bears in the Cave Task		Obj: To Explore Inverse Relationships (e.g., addition-subtraction) by Relying on More Abstract Material (i.e., Fingers, Pattern Rules) $3 + 2 = ?$
Inversion Piñata Task		Obj: To Solve for Inverse Relationships by Relying on More Concrete Material (e.g., counters) $6 + ? = 8$
Inversion Cookie Jar Task OR Bears in the Cave		Obj: To Solve for Inverse Relationships by Relying on More Abstract Material (i.e., Fingers, Pattern Rules) $5 + ? = 7$
