INFORMATION

STATE OF OKLAHOMA, COUNTY OF CANADIAN:

I, Cathy Stocker, the undersigned District Attorney of said County, in the name and by the authority, and on behalf of the State of Oklahoma, give information that on or about the 12th day of January, 2009, in Canadian County and in the State of Oklahoma, Joshua Steven Durcho, did then and there unlawfully, willfully, knowingly and wrongfully commit the crimes of:

COUNT 1

FIRST DEGREE MURDER, a felony, in violation of Oklahoma State Statute Title 21, Section 701.7, by deliberately and intentionally taking the life of a human being when the Defendant did then and there willfully, unlawfully and with malice aforethought, effect the death of Summer Garas by strangling Summer Garas, thereby inflicting certain mortal wounds in the body of Summer Garas from which mortal wounds she did languish and die.

COUNT 2

FIRST DEGREE MURDER, a felony, in violation of Oklahoma State Statute Title 21, Section 701.7, by deliberately and intentionally taking the life of a human being when the Defendant did then and there willfully, unlawfully and with malice aforethought, effect the death of Autumn Rust by strangling Autumn Rust, thereby inflicting certain mortal wounds in the body of Autumn Rust from which mortal wounds she did languish and die.

COUNT 3

FIRST DEGREE MURDER, a felony, in violation of Oklahoma State Statute Title 21, Section 701.7, by deliberately and intentionally taking the life of a human being when the Defendant did then and there willfully, unlawfully and with malice aforethought, effect the death of Kirsten Rust by strangling Kirsten Rust, thereby inflicting certain mortal wounds in the body of Kirsten Rust from which mortal wounds she did languish and die.

COUNT 4

FIRST DEGREE MURDER, a felony, in violation of Oklahoma State Statute Title 21, Section 701.7, by deliberately and intentionally taking the life of a human being when the Defendant did then and there willfully, unlawfully and with malice aforethought, effect the death of Evynn Garas by strangling Evynn Garas, thereby inflicting certain mortal wounds in the body of Evynn Garas from which mortal wounds she did languish and die.

COUNT 5

FIRST DEGREE MURDER, a felony, in violation of Oklahoma State Statute Title 21, Section 701.7, by deliberately and intentionally taking the life of a human being when the Defendant did then and there willfully, unlawfully and with malice aforethought, effect the death of Teagin Rust by strangling Teagin Rust, thereby inflicting certain mortal wounds in the body of Teagin Rust from which mortal wounds he did languish and die.

All of which is contrary to the form of the Statutes in such cases made and provided and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.
