SUMMARY

I, Jason Bass, a Deputy Sheriff with the Oklahoma County Sheriff's Office currently assigned to the Special Investigations Division, in Oklahoma County, Oklahoma, having acquired Advanced Peace Officer Certification and having been certified as a Peace Officer by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training within the State of Oklahoma for the past 12 years, do hereby swear and affirm that:

On Monday, August 27, 2012, at 1150 hours, Michael Coleman while in the performance of his official duties as a Detention Officer with the Oklahoma County Sheriff's Office used his fists and a set of metal keys to strike incarcerated Inmate Shawn Rose in the face and head area causing a laceration on his left ear.

During a search of his personal property, a functional cellular phone and a 7 inch folding knife was found which Coleman admitted to carrying on the secured side of the detention center which is violation of agency policy and state law.

This occurred within the Oklahoma County Detention Center located in Oklahoma City.
