AFFIDAVIT

The undersigned upon oath deposes and states as follows, to-wit:
 That the AFFIANT is employed by the Norman Police Department. That on or about the 8th day of October 2012, at 1111 Oaktree Building N Norman, Cleveland County, Oklahoma, the undersigned further states as follows:

On the above date at approximately 1930 hours members of the Norman Police Special Investigations Division conducted a controlled deliver of four pounds of "high grade" marijuana that had been intercepted by OKCPD detectives.

Detectives determined that POWELL was expecting the marijuana to be delivered from California via FedEx. POWELL had arranged for the marijuana to be delivered to a subject's house. The subject was told the FedEx package contained shoes. Once the package had been delivered POWELL arranged for another subject to pick up the package of "shoes" and bring it to him. Detectives directed the subject to deliver the marijuana to POWELL at his apartment at 1111 Oaktree Building N apt 255 as POWELL requested.

Detectives arranged for a surveillance and arrest team to be in the parking lot before the subject delivered the package. The subject carried the package to the apartment building and walked up the stairs to the second floor landing and began walking to POWELL's apartment. POWELL was waiting outside of his apartment. POWELL took the package from the subject. POWELL went down the stairs quickly and around the east side of the building. The subject came back down after delivering the package. POWELL disappeared as was not seen by surveillance

Your Affiant along with Detective Puckett contacted a group of people who came out of POWELL's apartment. Your Affiant had one of the subjects call POWELL. Once POWELL answered your Affiant spoke to him on the phone. Your Affiant told POWELL he wanted the box back and we needed to talk. POWELL asked your Affiant if he would come and meet him alone. Your Affiant agreed to meet him with Detective Puckett. POWELL told me to come to the University Greens Apartments and meet him at the office.

Your Affiant drove to the office and found POWELL sitting outside the office. Your Affiant introduced himself to POWELL. Your Affiant then told POWELL that he knew he had expected the marijuana to be delivered from California. POWELL stated that he knew the package contained marijuana. POWELL said he was only holding the package until an unknown person came and picked it up. POWELL said he would only get a little bit of money or marijuana to give to "the girls" for doing this. Your Affiant told POWELL he needed the package of marijuana. POWELL told your Affiant he would show your Affiant where he had put the package.


POWELL got in the front seat of the truck your Affiant was driving and he took your Affiant back to 1111 Oaktree building N. POWELL walked over to the eastside of the building and pointed out the package that was hidden between the bushes and the air conditioner unit. Your Affiant confirmed that the package still contained the marijuana. POWELL was released at the scene pending formal charges.


