INDICTMENT

FOR:

CONSPIRACY TO COMMIT A FELONY in violation of Title 21 O.S. § 421
[COUNT 1]

EMBEZZLEMENT in violation of Title 21 O.S. § 341 [COUNTS 2- 152]

IN THE NAME AND BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

By the order of the Supreme Court of Oklahoma, the Twelfth Multicounty Grand Jury was convened with its principal site to be in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma County, Oklahoma, to serve from March 31, 2009, until September 30, 2010, or until the designated presiding judge determines the Twelfth Multicounty Grand Jury has reached reasonable completion of its investigations, but in any event, no more than twenty-four (24) months from the commencement of its term. That the said Multicounty Grand Jury of the State of Oklahoma, being composed of good and lawful men and

woman, legally drawn and summons according to law and then and there examined, impeached, sworn and charged according to law to diligently inquire into and true presentment make of all public offenses against the State of Oklahoma committed and triable within the State of Oklahoma, upon their oath and in the name and by the authority of the State of Oklahoma, do present and find that:

COUNT 1:

During a period commencing upon an unknown date in the year 2002, but including the 1st day of January, 2002, A.D. , through an unknown date in year 2008, at all times relevant conspired to embezzle public funds as described herein, defendant, **ANNA NAUKAM**, was employed by the Oklahoma Court Appointed Special Advocate Association (“association”), an organization which receives funding from various sources including but not limited to, appropriations from the State of Oklahoma, federal funding, private donations and various grants. The association office is presently located at 3813 North Santa Fe Avenue, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma County, Oklahoma. The primary purpose of the association is to provide support to local Court Appointed Special Advocate (“CASA”) offices located throughout the state. The association does not provide direct services to clients. The primary mission of the association is to present a statewide voice for abused and neglected children by enhancing the growth of CASA programs throughout Oklahoma.

The defendant **ANNA NAUKAM** was employed by the association from September 10, 1998 to September 2, 2008 and served as the executive director for the association during most of her employment with the association. As such, **ANNA NAUKAM** had full access, control and custody of all association records including but not limited to all bank records, grant funding, credit card statements, accounts payable and accounts receivable, among other things. As well, **ANNA NAUKAM**, employed defendant **EUGENE NAUKAM** to serve as a special projects coordinator

for the association. Defendant **EUGENE NAUKAM** , also the husband of defendant **ANNA NAUKAM**, was employed by the association from February 2006 to September 2008.

On a date unknown in 2001, defendant **ANNA NAUKAM**, obtained a credit card in the name of the association. The address used in reference to said credit card is 416 Santa Fe Terrace, Edmond, Oklahoma, Oklahoma County, State of Oklahoma. As well, prior to defendant **EUGENE NAUKAM**'s employment with the association on an unknown date in 2002, **EUGENE NAUKAM**, obtained a credit card in the name of the association. The address used in reference to said credit card is 416 Santa Fe Terrace, Edmond, Oklahoma, Oklahoma County. At all times relevant to the events described herein, both **ANNA NAUKAM** and **EUGENE NAUKAM** resided at 416 Santa Fe Terrace , Edmond, Oklahoma. The referenced credit cards were knowingly and willfully used by defendants **ANNA NAUKAM** and **EUGENE NAUKAM** for non business related expenses. Furthermore payments toward the indebtedness incurred on the referenced credit cards were made by defendants **ANNA NAUKAM** and/or **EUGENE NAUKAM** from association funds including state appropriations, federal funds, grant awards and private donations thereby depriving the abused and neglected children of the benefit they would have otherwise received had the referenced funding been used according to its intended purpose. Accordingly, defendants **ANNA NAUKAM** and **EUGENE NAUKAM** impaired, obstructed and defeated the mission for which the association is intended to support and that pursuant to said unlawful agreement the following overt acts were committed:

1. On or about July 1, 2002 through November 21, 2008, **ANNA NAUKAM** and **EUGENE NAUKAM** made 83 individual purchases from *Home Depot* using an association credit card totaling \$14, 249.80.

2. On or about July 1, 2002 through November 21, 2008, **ANNA NAUKAM** and **EUGENE NAUKAM** made 76 individual purchases from *Kohl's Department Store* using an association credit card totaling \$13,820.54.
3. On or about July 1, 2002 through November 21, 2008, **ANNA NAUKAM** and **EUGENE NAUKAM** made 74 individual purchases from *Foley's Department Store* using an association credit card totaling \$10,342.53.
4. On or about July 1, 2002 through November 21, 2008, **ANNA NAUKAM** and **EUGENE NAUKAM** made 55 individual purchases from *Victoria Secret* using an association credit card totaling \$6,384.87.
5. On or about July 1, 2002 through November 21, 2008, **ANNA NAUKAM** and **EUGENE NAUKAM** made 39 individual purchases from *Eddie Baur Clothing Store* using the association credit card totaling \$6,259.65.
6. On or about July 1, 2002 through November 21, 2008, **ANNA NAUKAM** and **EUGENE NAUKAM** made 31 individual transactions with *The Limu Company*, a multi-level marketing company, using the association credit card totaling \$5,285.55.
7. On or about July 1, 2002 through November 21, 2008, **ANNA NAUKAM** and **EUGENE NAUKAM** made 20 payments to the *University of Oklahoma* for tuition payments using the association credit card totaling \$13,506.69.
8. On or about July 1, 2002 through November 21, 2008, **ANNA NAUKAM** and **EUGENE NAUKAM** made 68 individual purchases or transactions in Lubbock, Texas including but not limited to the purchase of *Texas Tech University Athletic Tickets*, *Tech Traditions*, and the *Texas Tech Alumni Association* in Lubbock, Texas

using an association credit card totaling \$14, 016.95.

9. On or about July 1, 2002 through November 21, 2008, **ANNA NAUKAM** and **EUGENE NAUKAM** paid costs for material and labor for the installation of granite counter tops, which were installed in the kitchen and bathroom of the residence located at 416 Santa Fe Terrace, Edmond, Oklahoma and occupied by defendants **ANNA NAUKAM** and **EUGENE NAUKAM**, using the association credit card totaling \$14, 249.80.
10. On or about July 1, 2002 through November 21, 2008, **ANNA NAUKAM** and **EUGENE NAUKAM** paid costs for material and labor for the installation of flooring, which was installed in the residence located at 416 Santa Fe Terrace, Edmond, Oklahoma and occupied by defendants **ANNA NAUKAM** and **EUGENE NAUKAM**, using an association credit card and totaling \$ 5,376.40.
11. On or about July 1, 2002 through November 21, 2008, **ANNA NAUKAM** and **EUGENE NAUKAM** paid for a hot tub, which was delivered and installed at the residence located at 416 Santa Fe Terrace, Edmond, Oklahoma and occupied by defendants **ANNA NAUKAM** and **EUGENE NAUKAM**, using an association credit card totaling \$14, 249.80.
12. On or about July 1, 2002 through November 21, 2008, **ANNA NAUKAM** and **EUGENE NAUKAM** made a payment to *Plastic Genetics* for cosmetic surgery using an association credit card totaling \$8,100.00.
13. On or about July 1, 2002 through November 21, 2008, **ANNA NAUKAM** and **EUGENE NAUKAM** made payments toward personal dental expenses using an

association credit card totaling \$2,408.62.

14. On or about July 1, 2002 through November 21, 2008, **ANNA NAUKAM** and **EUGENE NAUKAM** made payments in the amount of \$1,897.00 for personal subscription services including *Presbyterian Hospital Health Club*, *Netflix*, *Monthly Clubs.com* and *Playboy magazine*.
15. On or about July 1, 2002 through November 21, 2008, **ANNA NAUKAM** and **EUGENE NAUKAM** generated five (5) cash advances totaling \$13,000.00 from an association credit card.
16. On or about July 1, 2002 through November 21, 2008, **ANNA NAUKAM** and **EUGENE NAUKAM** purchased three (3) vacation packages from *Funjet Vacations* using an association credit card totaling \$4,021.88.
17. On or about July 1, 2002 through November 21, 2008, **ANNA NAUKAM** and **EUGENE NAUKAM** generated 22 individual transactions at establishments located in Cozumel, Mexico using an association credit card totaling \$1,963.98.
18. On or about July 1, 2002 through November 21, 2008, **ANNA NAUKAM** and **EUGENE NAUKAM** generated 12 individual transactions for payment to *Visiting Veterinarians* from an association credit card totaling \$1,800.95.
19. On or about July 1, 2002 through November 21, 2008, **ANNA NAUKAM** and **EUGENE NAUKAM** caused fees to be incurred on the association credit cards including but not limited to “over limit fees”, “cash advance charges”, “late fees”, “pay by phone fees” and “finance charges” totaling \$8,239.46.
20. On or about July 1, 2002 through November 21, 2008, **ANNA NAUKAM** made

payments from funds which were held in an association bank account toward the herein enumerated expenditures incurred on an association credit card for expenses having no official business purpose.

21. On or about July 1, 2002 through November 21, 2008, **EUGENE NAUKAM** caused payments to be made from funds which were held in an association bank account toward the herein enumerated expenditures incurred on an association credit card for expenses having no official business purpose.

All of the aforesaid being committed in furtherance of **ANNA NAUKAM** and **EUGENE NAUKAM**'s conspiracy to commit the felony, embezzlement, in Oklahoma County, Oklahoma and contrary to the provisions of Section 421 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes and against the Peace and Dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

Count 2:

Commencing on or about the 23rd day of September, 2002, A.D., within the County of Oklahoma, State of Oklahoma, the defendant, **ANNA NAUKAM**, did commit the crime of **EMBEZZLEMENT**. That is to say that during all times set forth above, and within the County and State aforesaid, defendant **ANNA NAUKAM**, an employee of the Oklahoma Court Appointed Special Advocate Association used association funds, including but not limited to public funds, to make a payment in the amount of \$ 1,564.00 toward indebtedness incurred on an association credit card used by **ANNA NAUKAM** for purchases and expenses having no official business purpose, such act being committed contrary to the provisions of Section 341 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and against the Peace and Dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

Count 3:

Commencing on or about the 5th day of November, 2002, A.D., within the County of Oklahoma, State of Oklahoma, the defendant, ANNA NAUKAM, did commit the crime of **EMBEZZLEMENT**. That is to say that during all times set forth above, and within the County and State aforesaid, defendant ANNA NAUKAM., an employee of the Oklahoma Court Appointed Special Advocate Association used association funds, including but not limited to public funds, to make a payment in the amount of \$4,554.86 toward indebtedness incurred on an association credit card used by ANNA NAUKAM for purchases and expenses having no official business purpose, such act being committed contrary to the provisions of Section 341 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and against the Peace and Dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

Count 4:

Commencing on or about the 2nd day of December, 2002, A.D., within the County of Oklahoma, State of Oklahoma, the defendant, ANNA NAUKAM, did commit the crime of **EMBEZZLEMENT**. That is to say that during all times set forth above, and within the County and State aforesaid, defendant ANNA NAUKAM., an employee of the Oklahoma Court Appointed Special Advocate Association used association funds, including but not limited to public funds, to make a payment in the amount of \$ 2,358.64 toward indebtedness incurred on an association credit card used by ANNA NAUKAM for purchases and expenses having no official business purpose, such act being committed contrary to the provisions of Section 341 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and against the Peace and Dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

Count 5:

Commencing on or about the 19th day of December, 2002, A.D., within the County of

Oklahoma, State of Oklahoma, the defendant, **ANNA NAUKAM**, did commit the crime of **EMBEZZLEMENT**. That is to say that during all times set forth above, and within the County and State aforesaid, defendant **ANNA NAUKAM**., an employee of the Oklahoma Court Appointed Special Advocate Association used association funds, including but not limited to public funds, to make a payment in the amount of \$ 3,779.12 toward indebtedness incurred on an association credit card used by **ANNA NAUKAM** for purchases and expenses having no official business purpose, such act being committed contrary to the provisions of Section 341 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and against the Peace and Dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

Count 6:

Commencing on or about the 2nd day of February, 2003, A.D., within the County of Oklahoma, State of Oklahoma, the defendant, **ANNA NAUKAM**, did commit the crime of **EMBEZZLEMENT**. That is to say that during all times set forth above, and within the County and State aforesaid, defendant **ANNA NAUKAM**., an employee of the Oklahoma Court Appointed Special Advocate Association used association funds, including but not limited to public funds, to make a payment in the amount of \$ 3,752.24 toward indebtedness incurred on an association credit card used by **ANNA NAUKAM** for purchases and expenses having no official business purpose, such act being committed contrary to the provisions of Section 341 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and against the Peace and Dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

Count 7:

Commencing on or about the 6th day of March, 2003, A.D., within the County of Oklahoma, State of Oklahoma, the defendant, **ANNA NAUKAM**, did commit the crime of **EMBEZZLEMENT**. That is to say that during all times set forth above, and within the County and

State aforesaid, defendant **ANNA NAUKAM.**, an employee of the Oklahoma Court Appointed Special Advocate Association used association funds, including but not limited to public funds, to make a payment in the amount of \$ 1,305.81 toward indebtedness incurred on an association credit card used by **ANNA NAUKAM** for purchases and expenses having no official business purpose, such act being committed contrary to the provisions of Section 341 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and against the Peace and Dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

Count 8:

Commencing on or about the 24th day of March, 2003, A.D., within the County of Oklahoma, State of Oklahoma, the defendant, **ANNA NAUKAM**, did commit the crime of **EMBEZZLEMENT**. That is to say that during all times set forth above, and within the County and State aforesaid, defendant **ANNA NAUKAM.**, an employee of the Oklahoma Court Appointed Special Advocate Association used association funds, including but not limited to public funds, to make a payment in the amount of \$ 2,057.38 toward indebtedness incurred on an association credit card used by **ANNA NAUKAM** for purchases and expenses having no official business purpose, such act being committed contrary to the provisions of Section 341 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and against the Peace and Dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

Count 9:

Commencing on or about the 11th day of April, 2003, A.D., within the County of Oklahoma, State of Oklahoma, the defendant, **ANNA NAUKAM**, did commit the crime of **EMBEZZLEMENT**. That is to say that during all times set forth above, and within the County and State aforesaid, defendant **ANNA NAUKAM.**, an employee of the Oklahoma Court Appointed Special Advocate Association used association funds, including but not limited to public funds, to

make a payment in the amount of \$ 2,823.91 toward indebtedness incurred on an association credit card used by ANNA NAUKAM for purchases and expenses having no official business purpose, such act being committed contrary to the provisions of Section 341 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and against the Peace and Dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

Count 10:

Commencing on or about the 20th day of May, 2003, A.D., within the County of Oklahoma, State of Oklahoma, the defendant, ANNA NAUKAM, did commit the crime of **EMBEZZLEMENT**. That is to say that during all times set forth above, and within the County and State aforesaid, defendant ANNA NAUKAM., an employee of the Oklahoma Court Appointed Special Advocate Association used association funds, including but not limited to public funds, to make a payment in the amount of \$ 3,012.40 toward indebtedness incurred on an association credit card used by ANNA NAUKAM for purchases and expenses having no official business purpose, such act being committed contrary to the provisions of Section 341 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and against the Peace and Dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

Count 11:

Commencing on or about the 20th day of June, 2003, A.D., within the County of Oklahoma, State of Oklahoma, the defendant, ANNA NAUKAM, did commit the crime of **EMBEZZLEMENT**. That is to say that during all times set forth above, and within the County and State aforesaid, defendant ANNA NAUKAM., an employee of the Oklahoma Court Appointed Special Advocate Association used association funds, including but not limited to public funds, to make a payment in the amount of \$ 3,549.23 toward indebtedness incurred on an association credit card used by ANNA NAUKAM for purchases and expenses having no official business purpose,

such act being committed contrary to the provisions of Section 341 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and against the Peace and Dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

Count 12:

Commencing on or about the 30th day of July, 2003, A.D., within the County of Oklahoma, State of Oklahoma, the defendant, **ANNA NAUKAM**, did commit the crime of **EMBEZZLEMENT**. That is to say that during all times set forth above, and within the County and State aforesaid, defendant **ANNA NAUKAM**., an employee of the Oklahoma Court Appointed Special Advocate Association used association funds, including but not limited to public funds, to make a payment in the amount of \$ 4,977.36 toward indebtedness incurred on an association credit card used by **ANNA NAUKAM** for purchases and expenses having no official business purpose, such act being committed contrary to the provisions of Section 341 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and against the Peace and Dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

Count 13:

Commencing on or about the 9th day of September, 2003, A.D., within the County of Oklahoma, State of Oklahoma, the defendant, **ANNA NAUKAM**, did commit the crime of **EMBEZZLEMENT**. That is to say that during all times set forth above, and within the County and State aforesaid, defendant **ANNA NAUKAM**., an employee of the Oklahoma Court Appointed Special Advocate Association used association funds, including but not limited to public funds, to make a payment in the amount of \$ 2,261.62 toward indebtedness incurred on an association credit card used by **ANNA NAUKAM** for purchases and expenses having no official business purpose, such act being committed contrary to the provisions of Section 341 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and against the Peace and Dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

Count 14:

Count 15:

That is to say that during all times set forth above, and within the County and State aforesaid, defendant **ANNA NAUKAM**., an employee of the Oklahoma Court Appointed Special Advocate Association used association funds, including but not limited to public funds, to make a payment in the amount of \$ 1,986.00 toward indebtedness incurred on an association credit card used by **ANNA NAUKAM** for purchases and expenses having no official business purpose, such act being committed contrary to the provisions of Section 341 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and against the Peace and Dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

Count 16:

Commencing on or about the 30th day of October, 2003, A.D., within the County of Oklahoma, State of Oklahoma, the defendant, ANNA NAUKAM, did commit the crime of **EMBEZZLEMENT**. That is to say that during all times set forth above, and within the County and State aforesaid, defendant ANNA NAUKAM., an employee of the Oklahoma Court Appointed Special Advocate Association used association funds, including but not limited to public funds, to make a payment in the amount of \$3,000.00 toward indebtedness incurred on an association credit card used by ANNA NAUKAM for purchases and expenses having no official business purpose, such act being committed contrary to the provisions of Section 341 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and against the Peace and Dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

Count 17:

Commencing on or about the 20th day of November, 2003, A.D., within the County of Oklahoma, State of Oklahoma, the defendant, ANNA NAUKAM, did commit the crime of **EMBEZZLEMENT**. That is to say that during all times set forth above, and within the County and State aforesaid, defendant ANNA NAUKAM., an employee of the Oklahoma Court Appointed Special Advocate Association used association funds, including but not limited to public funds, to make a payment in the amount of \$ 3,000.00 toward indebtedness incurred on an association credit card-used by ANNA NAUKAM for purchases and expenses having no official business purpose, such act being committed contrary to the provisions of Section 341 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and against the Peace and Dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

Count 18:

That is to say that during all times set forth above, and within the County and State aforesaid, defendant **ANNA NAUKAM**, an employee of the Oklahoma Court Appointed Special Advocate Association used association funds, including but not limited to public funds, to make a payment in the amount of \$ 3,500.00 toward indebtedness incurred on an association credit card used by **ANNA NAUKAM** for purchases and expenses having no official business purpose, such act being committed contrary to the provisions of Section 341 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and against the Peace and Dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

Count 19:

Commencing on or about the 31st day of December, 2003, A.D., within the County of Oklahoma, State of Oklahoma, the defendant, **ANNA NAUKAM**, did commit the crime of **EMBEZZLEMENT**. That is to say that during all times set forth above, and within the County and State aforesaid, defendant **ANNA NAUKAM**, an employee of the Oklahoma Court Appointed Special Advocate Association used association funds, including but not limited to public funds, to make a payment in the amount of \$ 2,500.00 toward indebtedness incurred on an association credit card used by **ANNA NAUKAM** for purchases and expenses having no official business purpose, such act being committed contrary to the provisions of Section 341 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and against the Peace and Dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

Count 20:

Commencing on or about the 23rd day of January, 2004, A.D., within the County of Oklahoma, State of Oklahoma, the defendant, **ANNA NAUKAM**, did commit the crime of **EMBEZZLEMENT**. That is to say that during all times set forth above, and within the County and

State aforesaid, defendant **ANNA NAUKAM.**, an employee of the Oklahoma Court Appointed Special Advocate Association used association funds, including but not limited to public funds, to make a payment in the amount of \$ 2,500.00 toward indebtedness incurred on an association credit card used by **ANNA NAUKAM** for purchases and expenses having no official business purpose, such act being committed contrary to the provisions of Section 341 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and against the Peace and Dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

Count 21:

Commencing on or about the 15th day of March, 2004, A.D., within the County of Oklahoma, State of Oklahoma, the defendant, **ANNA NAUKAM**, did commit the crime of **EMBEZZLEMENT**. That is to say that during all times set forth above, and within the County and State aforesaid, defendant **ANNA NAUKAM.**, an employee of the Oklahoma Court Appointed Special Advocate Association used association funds, including but not limited to public funds, to make a payment in the amount of \$ 4,000.00 toward indebtedness incurred on an association credit card used by **ANNA NAUKAM** for purchases and expenses having no official business purpose, such act being committed contrary to the provisions of Section 341 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and against the Peace and Dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

Count 22:

Commencing on or about the 8th day of April , 2004, A.D., within the County of Oklahoma, State of Oklahoma, the defendant, **ANNA NAUKAM**, did commit the crime of **EMBEZZLEMENT**. That is to say that during all times set forth above, and within the County and State aforesaid, defendant **ANNA NAUKAM.**, an employee of the Oklahoma Court Appointed Special Advocate Association used association funds, including but not limited to public funds, to


