STIPULATION AND AGREED ORDER

COME NOW Travis White, Deputy General Counsel for the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control ("OBND"), and JAMES C. GRIFFITH, D.D.S., (Respondent) who stipulate and agree to the following findings of fact and conclusions of law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent was a registrant of Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics in 1998 having registration number 16528. On or on about October 31, 1998, Registrant failed to renew such registration which is required by Title 63.
2. Respondent continued to prescribe, dispense, and administer, Controlled Dangerous Substances from November 1998 through November 2010 without a current Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics registration. Such action is a violation of Title 63 O.S. §§ 2-302, 2-303(B) and 2-401 of the Oklahoma state statutes.
3. Both parties agree that Respondent's OBND registration should be granted subject to the following condition(s).

a) Respondent specifically agrees to pay an administrative penalty of five thousand dollars (\$7,500.00) for violations of Title 63 and OAC 475 and as specifically provided by 63 O.S. §2-304(D). *Full payment must be submitted contemporaneously with a signed original of this Order.*


CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs has jurisdiction over this matter and Respondent.
2. The Director of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs has the authority to render this Agreed Order.
3. Respondent continued to prescribe, dispense, and administer, Controlled Dangerous Substances from November 1998 through November 2010 without a current Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics registration. Such action is a violation of Title 63 O.S. §§ 2-302, 2-303(B) and 2-401 of the Oklahoma state statutes.

AGREED ORDER


Based on the above stipulation, findings of fact and conclusions of law, I hereby Order that Respondent's registration be granted with the restrictions as set forth above.
