I, Robert L. Hudson, the undersigned District Attorney of said County, in the name and by the authority, and on behalf of the State of Oklahoma, give information that in said County of Payne and in the State of Oklahoma, SEAN PATRICK SUTTON, did then and there unlawfully, willfully, knowingly and wrongfully commit the crime(s) of:

63 O.S. § 2-407(A)(1) ~ OBTAINING A CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCE -OXYCODONE - BY FRAUD, a FELONY, about the month of August, 2009, defendant fraudulently obtained prescriptions for controlled dangerous substances from multiple physicians and filled the prescriptions at multiple pharmacies.

This crime is punishable by a fine of \$10,000 and/or 10 years imprisonment.

63 O.S. § 2-402 ~ UNLAWFUL POSSESSION OF A CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCE - OXYCODONE - SCHEDULE II - WITHOUT A PRESCRIPTION, a FELONY, on or about the 11th day of February, 2010, by knowingly and intentionally having in defendant's possession under defendant's control oxycodone said drug being classified as a controlled dangerous substance in Schedule II of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Act of Oklahoma, without a prescription.

This crime is punishable by imprisonment up to 2 -10 years, and a fine of not more than \$5,000.

COUNT 3: 63 O.S. § 2-408 ~ ATTEMPTED POSSESSION OF CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCES – ADDERALL AND CLONAZAPAM – WITHOUT A PRESCRIPTION, a FELONY, on or about the 11th day of February, 2010, defendant attempted to receive a federal express package from Michelle Keller, Seattle, Washington, containing adderall and clonazapam said drugs being classified as controlled dangerous substances in Schedule II and IV of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Act of Oklahoma, without a prescription.

This crime is punishable by imprisonment from 2-10 years and/or a fine up to \$5,000.00.

COUNT 4: 13 O.S. § 176.3 ~ USE OF A COMMUNICATION FACILITY TO FACILITATE A FELONY – TO WIT: DISTRIBUTION OF CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCES, a FELONY, on or about the 11th day of February, 2010, by using a cellular telephone to call and text Michelle Keller to arrange the delivery of controlled dangerous substances, adderall and clonazapam.

This crime is punishable by imprisonment up to 5 years and/or a fine up to \$5,000.00.
