Narrative:

On 02-15-2009, at about, 1618 hours, I, Officer Penick, was dispatched to 1119 Sunset in reference to a domestic that had already occurred. Sgt Webster arrived just before I did.

Upon arrival, I made contact with Kristine Pontious in the driveway of the residence. Kristine was holding her lower back on the left side. I asked Kristine what happened. Kristine said she had been arguing with her husband, Bradley Pontious, of seven years, and her son Dewight Ares. Kristine said she asked Bradley to home from work to get Dewight and his wife Davetta Ares out of the house. Kristine told me when Bradley got home he was mad and pushed her down twice in the bedroom. Kristine said she begged Bradley to take Dewight and Davetta with him to work so they would leave her alone, but he refused. Kristine said Bradley just asked them to stay upstairs.

While talking with Kristine, she asked that Sgt. Webster and I make Dewight and Davetta leave her house. I explained to Kristine that I could not make them leave because they live in the home. Kristine was extremely upset and asked I speak with them. I asked Kristine were they were at and she told me inside upstairs. Kristine gave Sgt. Webster and me permission to enter her house to make contact with Dewight and Davetta.

Sgt Webster and I both knocked on the door before we entered. We entered the residence and announced our presence. Dewight came down stairs to speak with us. Dewight told me Kristine has a drinking problem and has been arguing with the family for days. Dewight said it has gotten so bad Bradley went and stayed at a motel last night. Dewight told me she did not see Bradley push Kristine down. Dewight said Davetta had a seizer in the living room while they were arguing in the bedroom.

Sgt Webster went upstairs to speak with Davetta about the incident.

After investigating the domestic, I then address another issued I located when we had entered the residence. When Sgt Webster and I entered the residence, we were overwhelmed by the smell of ammonia believed to be from cat urine. Every where I looked I could see cats. The cats were in the cabinets, on the tables, running around the floor, and etc. I was not able to see the floor in the living room and dining room from animal feces and animal hair. Sgt Webster and I both believed there to be over fifty cats inside the house. I looked inside the bathroom upstairs and it was full of animal feces. While Sgt. Webster was upstairs, Dewight told me they did not have any heat because the gas was shut off. There were also electrical wires exposed throughout the whole house.

Sgt Webster also called Clarence Sanders to come to our location. Sanders arrived and photographed the residence and condemned it for occupancy. Sgt. Webster called ACO Weider and ACO Townsend to come to our location. ACO Weider and ACO Townsend arrived and Sgt Webster and I helped them remove all the cats from the residence.

While we were removing the cats from the house, Bradley came home. I spoke with him about the incident. Bradley told me he has been arguing with Kristine since yesterday. Bradley confirmed he went to a motel last night. Bradley said he was received a call from Kristine to return home from work, due to an argument between Dewight and Kristine. Bradley said when he arrived home Kristine began to argue with him again. Bradley told me during the argument Kristine pushed him stumbled over a cat and she fell down. Bradley asked Kristine if she was ok then left the house to avoid further verbal or physical altercation.

We removed eighty two cats and three dogs from inside the residence. All the animals other than the three dogs and four cats where taken to the shelter. The three dogs were taken by Dewight to his friends' house to be given away and the four cats were kept by Kristine and Bradley. I photographed the entire house.

There are not any charges at this time of report due to no evidence of and physical altercation occurred. Both parties were given a safe line cards. I have nothing further at this time.
