AFFIDAVIT

The undersigned, upon oath, deposes and states as follows, to wit:

I, Les Little, am a Police Officer employed by the Stillwater Police Department. I am currently assigned to the Criminal Investigation Division.

On 12/15/2010, a letter was delivered to the Stillwater Police Department. The letter detailed a sexual assault that occurred at a Stillwater residence during a college party on 12/12/2010. The letter told a story of three females being assaulted by members of the Oklahoma State University (OSU) Basketball team. The letter named Darrell Williams, Marshall Moses and a black male named "Yayi" as suspects. The author of the letter said the three female victims wished to remain anonymous. An investigation was started by the Stillwater Police Department and the three victims described in the letter were identified.

I interviewed, a 20-year-old female, and she told me she was sexually battered by several members of the OSU basketball team. reported she could not identify all the suspects. could positively identify two suspects and described the things they did to her. told me she was assaulted by Darrell Williams and "Yayi" while attending a party between the hours of 0145 and 0300 at a residence that was later determined to be 423 S. Lewis, Stillwater, Payne County, Oklahoma. told me while talking to "Yayi" he placed his hand down the back of her pants under her underwear touching her buttocks. When

tried to remove "Yayi's" hand, he told her to relax and forced his hand further down the back of her pants grabbing her buttocks. said "Yayi" would forcefully pull her hand and place it against his penis.

reported several other unidentified OSU basketball players surrounded her and began groping her body. said when she was being groped by the basketball players she felt a hand go down the front of her pants under her underwear and a finger enter her vagina. said Darrell Williams was the person who put his hand down the front of her pants and inserted his finger into her vagina.

further positively identified Darrell Williams from a photo of the Oklahoma State University Men's Basketball team.

On 12/16/2010, Yayi Abouk Janneh was identified as "Yayi". Yayi Abouk Janneh's personal information and a photograph were obtained. I placed Yayi Abouk Janneh's photograph in a photograph line-up and positively identified Yayi Abouk Janneh as the person who assaulted her.

Based on this information, the undersigned prays that this Honorable Court issue a finding of fact that probable cause exists to believe that a crime has been committed and that there is probable cause to believe the defendant(s) above named committed that crime.

The letter told a story of three females being assaulted by members of the Oklahoma State University (OSU) Basketball team. The letter named Darrell Williams, Marshall Moses and a black male named "Yayi" as suspects. The author of the letter said the three female victims wished to remain anonymous. An investigation was started by the Stillwater Police Department and the three victims described in the letter were identified.

Sgt. Jeff Watts interviewed a 22-year-old female. reported she was sexually assaulted by an OSU basketball player named "Darrell" and another player she could not identify while attending a party that was later determined to be located at 423 S. Lewis, Stillwater, Payne County, Oklahoma. reported she was invited to the party at 423 S. Lewis by an acquaintance named "Yayi". reported during the party "Darrell" and the unknown player began groping her body from her waist to over her breast, to down her back pocket and buttocks. told "Darrell" and the other player to stop and she moved away from them. A few minutes later realized she was missing her photo ID and \$10 from her back pocket. contacted "Darrell" and asked him if he had taken the items. "Darrell" denied taking the items and told he would help her look for her property. "Darrell" followed outside to the yard. In the backyard of 423 S. Lewis, "Darrell" became more forceful with and forced

both his hands down her pants. tried to remove "Darrell's" hands, "Darrell" tightened his grip and told stop moving. "Darrell" told she would be "getting his dick tonight" and forced his fingers inside her vagina. struggled and broke free from "Darrell".

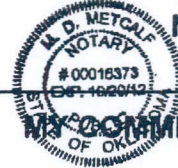
 said she could positively identify "Darrell". Sgt. Watts showed a photograph of the 2010 Oklahoma State University Men's Basketball team. positively identified Darrell Williams as the "Darrell" who assaulted her.
