RE: OPEN RECORDS ACT and FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT REQUEST


Dear Mr. Evans:

This is to advise you that I represent INAD Data, LLC with regard to the above-referenced matter. Pursuant to the Oklahoma Open Records Act, 51 O.S. § 24A, *et seq.* and the federal Freedom of Information Act, 5 USC § 552, *et seq.* as amended, I hereby request copies, in electronic format, of all information, documents and records that are provided electronically to either KellPro or OSCN.net This request is inclusive of all court records, including all Worker's Compensation records, which are maintained by all Oklahoma Courts. This request is to supplement my request of July 7, 2009.

The phrase "information, documents and records" is used in a comprehensive sense and includes but is not limited to all hand-written, typed, printed, recorded, transcribed copies or reproductions of every kind and description. This includes letters, memoranda, telegrams, notes, reports, details of accounts, minutes, work sheets, computer printouts, contracts, proceedings and any type or other compilation from which information can be obtained. This includes only documents already in electronic format. If you regard any information, documents or records in the foregoing list as exempt from required disclosure under the Act, I hereby request that you exercise your discretion under the Act to disclose them nonetheless. I further request that you disclose the listed information, documents and records as they become available to you, without waiting until all information, documents and records have been assembled. As you know, the Freedom of Information Act provides that if portions of a document or record are exempt from release, the remainder must be segregated and disclosed. Therefore I will expect you to send me all nonexempt portions of the information, documents and records that I have requested, and ask that you justify any deletions by reference to specific exemptions of the Act. I reserve the right to appeal your decision to withhold any information, documents and records. I agree to pay reasonable fees incurred in the copying of these documents up to \$100.00. If the estimated fees will be greater than that amount, please contact me by telephone before such expenses are incurred.

I ask that if any questions arise concerning this request, you notify me by telephone rather than by letter at the number listed above. I am normally there between 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. I am more than willing to be flexible in this request and assist in any manner possible. I wish to cooperate with your office. Feel free to call me at any time should there be questions regarding this Freedom of Information Act Request.
