BODY OF REPORT:

ON 03-12-07, AT 0922 HOURS I WAS DISPATCHED TO 5900 S. PENNSYLVANIA, IN REFERENCE TO A SILENT HOLD-UP ALARM, AT RELIABLE DISCOUNT PHARMACY, WHICH IS AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF S.W. 58TH AND PENNSYLVANIA. I ARRIVED ON SCENE AT 0925 HOURS.

I WAS FLAGGED DOWN INITIALLY BY THREE WHITE MALE WITNESSES, PARKED ON S.W. 58TH STREET. SGT. R. ARMSTRONG #542, 1E99, INTERVIEWED THESE WITNESSES; SEE HIS SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT. THESE WITNESSES TOLD ME THAT OUR SUSPECT VEHICLE HAD JUST LEFT EASTBOUND ON S.W. 58TH STREET. THEY SAID OUR SUSPECTS WERE TWO BLACK MALES WITH A BLACK FEMALE DRIVER, IN AN OLDER MODEL, POSSIBLY BUICK, LARGE, 4-DOOR CAR. THE CAR WAS POSSIBLY BROWN OR BURGANDY IN COLOR. THERE WAS A PLASTIC BAG OVER THE TAG.

AFTER PUTTING OUT THE SUSPECT INFORMATION I WENT TO THE PHARMACY AND INTERVIEWED PHARMACIST, VI-3 DOUG SISEMORE. THIS VI SAID THAT TWO BLACK MALES CAME INTO THE STORE AND FORCED ALL THE EMPLOYEES INTO A BACK ROOM, WHILE THE OTHER BLACK MALE SUSPECT STOLE CASH AND A VERY LARGE QUANTITY OF PHARMACUTICAL DRUGS.

PHARMACY TECH, VI-2 BRENDA HATFIELD, WAS INITIALLY CONFRONTED BY THE SHORTER BLACK MALE SUSPECT, AND SHE WAS PRESENTED A ROUGHLY WRITTEN, POSSIBLY FRAUDULANT PRESCRIPTION. SHE DESCRIBED HIM AS WEARING A WHITE SHIRT AND BEING APPROXIMATELY 600/185. SHE SAID AS SHE WAS CHECKING THIS INFORMATION, THIS SUSPECT YELLED FOR THE SECOND SUSPECT TO COME INSIDE. THE FIRST SUSPECT AT THE COUNTER PRODUCED A SMALL, BLACK, POSSIBLY AUTOMATIC, HANDGUN. THE VICTIMS WERE TOLD TO GET ON THE FLOOR, AND THEN IMMEDIATELY TOLD TO GET BACK UP AND LAY DOWN, IN THE BACK OFFICE. VI-2 HATFIELD SAID THE SHORTER BLACK MALE SUSPECT WAS THE MOST AGGRESSIVE, HITTING HER IN THE BACK WITH THE HANDGUN, AND ALSO KICKING VI-4 HUMPHRIES, AND POSSIBLY ONE OR TWO MORE VICTIMS. THE SECOND SUSPECT WAS TALLER, APPROXIMATELY 602/200+. THIS SUSPECT WAS POSSIBLY NOT ARMED, AND ACCORDING TO THE VICTIMS REMOVED ALL OF THE CASH AND DRUGS FROM THE

SHELVES, AND PLACED THEM IN A BLACK, NET BAG. THE SUSPECTS ALSO COLLECTED THREE PURSES AND TWO WALLETS BELONGING TO THE VICTIMS. I WAS TOLD THAT VI-6 HOGUE, AND VI-5 READ, WERE THE COUNTER EMPLOYEES THAT PUSHED THE SILENT HOLD-UP ALARM.

SGT. D. KIDD #526 AND L313 LT. D. SHUBERT #477, ARRIVED ON MY SCENE AND ASSISTED. SGT. KIDD COLLECTED PERSONAL INFORMATION. SEE HIS SUPPLEMENTAL FOR DETAILS. LT. SHUBERT WAS THE SUPERVISOR IN CHARGE.

WHILE THIS ROBBERY WAS IN PROGRESS, CUSTOMER WI-1 JAMES PANNELL, CAME TO THE PHARMACY TO DO BUSINESS, AND KNOCKED ON THE GLASS DOOR. THE SUSPECTS TOLD VI-2 HATFIELD TO TELL W-1 PANNELL TO COME BACK AT 10 O'CLOCK. WI-1 PANNELL WAS INTERVIEWED BY ROBBERY DETECTIVE RIGGS #315, AT THE SCENE. DETECTIVE WILSON #800, ALSO ARRIVED ON MY SCENE, AND CONDUCTED HIS INVESTIGATION.

THE TWO BLACK MALE SUSPECTS RAN OUT OF THE STORE, NORTH TO THE WAITING CAR, ON S.W. 58TH STREET, AND FLED EASTBOUND. SEVERAL OFFICERS CONTINUED TO SEARCH THE AREA AS THIS CALL PROGRESSED, HOWEVER, THE SUSPECTS AND THEIR VEHICLE WERE NOT LOCATED.
