The pharmacist was able to retrieve a handgun and fire shots at the Suspects, hitting one of the suspects. The second suspect was able to run from the pharmacy and the pharmacist chased after the second suspect while firing shots at the suspect but not hitting the suspect. The suspect was seen getting into a tan colored Honda driven by a third suspect. The tan Honda left the scene eastbound on SW. 58th and drove to 1411 SW. 58th, where the vehicle was driven into a yard and stalled. The armed suspect seen running southbound from the vehicle. The suspect seen driving the Honda was arrested at 1411 SW. 58th and later identified as Emanuel Mitchell.


